Definition: A metal fixing fork for cap badge is a durable clip that holds a badge firmly in place on a beret or hat. It keeps the badge neat, secure and correctly positioned for a professional uniform appearance.

Attach the fork through the badge fixing points and press gently so the tuck fits the cap material. It is useful any time you need the badge to stay stable—during duty, parade, travel or storage.

Quick answer: Use it whenever a badge needs a secure, neat attachment to a beret or hat. In most cases, the fork fits standard badge mounts, but check the size to ensure a proper fit and to avoid stressing the cap fabric.

Care and notes

Basic care keeps the metal fork functional and prevents corrosion or wear over time.

- **Regular cleaning:** Wipe with a soft cloth to remove dirt and moisture after use.
- **Periodic inspection:** Check for wear, bent parts or loose fittings before wearing.
- **Proper storage:** Store in a dry place to reduce the risk of corrosion.
- **Size caution:** Choose the correct length and width to avoid damaging the cap material.

A: Stainless steel forks are highly resistant to corrosion and suitable for varying weather. Brass also resists wear but may require more care to avoid tarnish.

A: If the wrong size or an overly tight fit is used, the cap material can be stressed. Choose the correct size and fit it gently to avoid damage.
