Product overview

The Grado Sergente Cappello Alpino is a 12 mm sergeant rank badge designed for the Cappello Alpino (Alpini hat). It is intended for military personnel and collectors who need a regulation-looking rank insignia to add to their uniform.

Definition: a 12 mm rank emblem made of black flat fabric on grey cloth with a gold border, worn



on the left side of the Cappello Alpino. Ideal for military, tactical, and uniform use or for military surplus restoration.

Main features

Simple, durable construction and a classic look make this badge suitable for field use and ceremonial wear.

- **Size:** 12 mm height for clear visibility without bulk.
- **Material:** black flat fabric mounted on grey cloth, edged in gold thread.
- **Shape:** right-angled badge with the vertex pointing upwards.
- **Placement:** intended for the left side of the Cappello Alpino.
- **Match:** pairs with the Nappina in Metallo Dorato for a coordinated, regulation appearance.

How to use / When it's useful

Apply the Grado Sergente badge to the left side of the Cappello Alpino to indicate rank and maintain a uniform look for duty, ceremonies, or displays. Quick answer: attach it to the left side of the hat so the badge faces outward and is easily identified.

In most cases, the badge is used together with the Nappina in Metallo Dorato to complete the traditional Alpini hat appearance. Use this insignia for uniform upgrades, replacements in military surplus collections, or for tactical and ceremonial dress.

Care and notes

Maintain the badge with light, careful handling to preserve the fabric and gold edging.

- Spot clean with a damp cloth; avoid harsh chemicals or bleach.
- Store dry and flat to prevent bending or fraying of the edges.
- Recommended pairing: use with the Nappina in Metallo Dorato for a complete look.
- Availability may be limited; consider ordering sooner if needed for a specific event.

FAQ

Q: What are the exact dimensions of the badge?

A: The badge height is 12 mm. The compact size is chosen to be visible without adding bulk to the hat.

Q: What materials are used for the Grado Sergente badge?

A: It is made from black flat fabric applied to grey cloth and finished with a gold-edged border for a formal appearance.

A: Position the badge on the left side of the Cappello Alpino so it is clearly visible and consistent with standard placement.

A: While not mechanically required, pairing the badge with the Nappina in Metallo Dorato is recommended to achieve a complete, regulation-style look.

A: The badge is intended for Alpini hat use and for uniform presentation; check your unit or agency regulations before using it on other authorized headgear.
