It represents recognition linked to NATO operations launched after the September 11 attacks and is aimed at those who value military history and service symbols.



**Definition:** The NATO Article 5 Medal is a circular bronze medal modeled on the decoration associated with NATO Article 5 operations. The design includes the NATO star, an olive branch wreath, bilingual inscriptions, and a distinctive light-blue ribbon with white and gold stripes.

### Main features

A carefully produced commemorative piece, suitable for display, collection, or reference in historical and tactical gear inventories.

- **Material:** Bronze construction for durability and a classic appearance.
- **Size:** Available only in the 37 mm diameter format.

### Care and notes

- Store in a dry place away from direct sunlight to protect ribbon colors.
- Clean bronze gently with a soft cloth; avoid harsh chemicals that can damage the finish.
- Handle the ribbon carefully to prevent fraying or staining.
- Note limited availability—quantities are small due to demand.
- Check local and organizational rules before displaying or wearing on an official uniform.

**Q:** What are the dimensions of the medal?



**A:** The medal is available only in the 37 mm diameter format. This single size is the standard offered for this product.

**Q:** What material is the medal made from?

**A:** The medal is made of bronze, chosen for durability and a traditional appearance suitable for collectors and display.

**Q:** What do the ribbon colors mean?

**A:** The light-blue NATO ribbon with white side stripes symbolizes peace, while the central gold band represents the Article 5 operations associated with NATO activities.

**Q:** What inscriptions are on the medal?

**A:** The reverse is engraved with "North Atlantic Treaty Organization" and the phrase "at the service of peace and freedom" in both English and French.

**Q:** Is this an official NATO-issued medal?
