Main features

Care and notes

- Clean gently with a soft, dry cloth; avoid abrasive cleaners that can damage bronze.
- Handle by the ribbon or edges to reduce fingerprints on the medal face.
- Limited availability: demand can be high, so check current stock before deciding.
