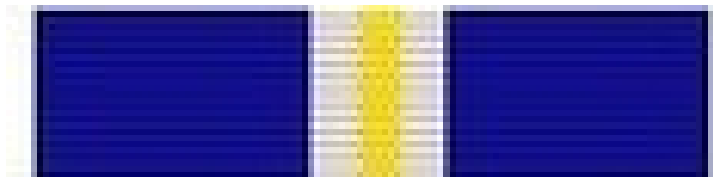

representing Article 5. This ribbon is suitable for use on uniform ribbon bars and as part of military surplus or tactical gear collections.

Use this ribbon when assembling duty or ceremonial ribbon bars, restoring military surplus gear, or curating a uniform display. It is appropriate for veterans' reunions, ceremonial wear, and archival collections where accurate representation of NATO-related awards is required.

### Care and notes

Handle and store the ribbon to preserve its color and shape; choose the correct attachment and bar type for secure mounting.

- Store in a cool, dry place to avoid fading or deformation.
- Match the 37 mm size and select flat or Elite to suit existing ribbons.
- Choose the correct mounting hardware (screws or clamps) when ordering to ensure proper fit.
- Availability is limited due to production and demand; consider ordering promptly if required.

**A:** The ribbon was issued to military and civilian personnel who participated in NATO operations in North American airspace following the 11 September 2001 attacks.

**A:** Yes. It is suitable for use on two- or multi-place metal ribbon bars and can be fitted alongside other service ribbons.

**Q:** What do the colors and symbols on the ribbon mean?

**A:** The NATO blue identifies the Alliance, the central white stripe symbolizes peace, and the gold line is intended to evoke Article 5 of the NATO treaty.

**Q:** Is this ribbon currently available?

**A:** Stock is limited due to production and demand. If you need this ribbon for uniform use or a collection, add it to your cart to reserve it while available.

**Tip:** Choose the flat 37 mm or the Elite domed variant to match your existing ribbons, and select the correct screws or clamps for your ribbon bar. Also consider browsing related ribbon bars and mounting accessories to complete your uniform or display.
