## Product overview

Travette Gala Ufficiali Inferiori Carristi are a pair of hand-embroidered gala shoulder boards for



lower-ranking Carristi officers, intended for formal and ceremonial uniforms. They are designed for officers from Sottotenente (Second Lieutenant) to Capitano (Captain) who need a polished, service-appropriate appearance.

Definition: these travette are hand-embroidered in gold bullion (canutiglia oro) and carry the Carristi emblem. Suitable for ceremonial military use, tactical dress displays, or military surplus collectors and duty presentations.

### Main features

Carefully crafted details and materials give these travette a refined look while clearly indicating rank and corps.

- **Hand-embroidered** pair, each stitched by hand for careful detail.
- **Gold bullion (canutiglia oro)** thread for long-lasting shine and traditional appearance.
- **Distinctive emblem:** two crossed mortars with a flame and a small tank below the intersection, identifying Carristi.
- **Rank indication** from Sottotenente (Second Lieutenant) to Capitano (Captain).
- **Designed to be sewn** onto the shoulders of a ceremonial uniform for a secure, official look.
- **Limited availability** due to the time required for manual embroidery.

### How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: sew the pair onto the shoulder panels of your ceremony uniform so they sit flat and aligned with existing insignia. Use a skilled tailor if you want a neat, long-lasting attachment.

In most cases, these travette are worn at formal parades, change-of-command events, and official ceremonies. They also work well for display, unit collections, or when replacing worn gala insignia in military surplus or duty kits.

### Care and notes

Treat the travette as delicate items because of the gold bullion embroidery; handle and store them carefully to preserve appearance.

- Keep dry and store flat to avoid crushing the embroidery.
- Prefer professional dry cleaning or spot cleaning; avoid machine washing to protect the gold thread.
- Have a tailor sew them in place to ensure correct positioning and avoid damage to the uniform.
- Limited stock: allow extra time for fulfilment due to hand-embroidery.

### FAQ



**Q:** Which ranks do these travette represent?

**A:** They represent the ranks from Sottotenente (Second Lieutenant) up to Capitano (Captain). The gold frame and emblem denote these lower officer grades.

**Q:** How are the travette attached to the uniform?

**A:** The pair is intended to be sewn onto the shoulders of the ceremonial uniform. We recommend a professional tailor for neat and secure attachment.

**Q:** What material are the travette made from?

**A:** The travette are hand-embroidered using gold bullion thread (canutiglia oro). They are sold as a pair, one for each shoulder.

**Q:** What does the internal emblem depict?

**A:** The internal fregio shows two crossed mortars with a flame and a small tank beneath the intersection, a traditional symbol associated with Carristi.

**Q:** Are these travette produced in limited quantities?

**A:** Yes. Because each pair is hand-embroidered, production is limited and availability can be restricted. Order early to avoid delays.

**Q:** Can the travette be removed or exchanged later?

**A:** They are designed to be sewn on; removal is possible but may leave small stitch marks. Consult your tailor before altering or removing them to avoid damage.

**Tip:** Choose the correct rank variant before ordering and consider ordering matching items for a consistent ceremony kit; browse related military surplus and tactical duty insignia to complete your uniform set.
