Product overview

The Unified Protector NATO 2011 ribbon is a service ribbon awarded to Aeronautica Militare personnel who served during Operation NATO Unified Protector (23 March–31 October 2011). It is intended for veterans, serving members, and collectors of military ribbons and military surplus items. Definition: a service ribbon recognizing operational service during NATO Unified Protector.



The ribbon features the ISAF-based graphic with a central bronzed metal clasp engraved "UNIFIED PROTECTOR." It is of interest to duty personnel, tactical gear collectors, and anyone preserving military service insignia or police/duty memorabilia.

Main features

Key features and options for the Unified Protector NATO 2011 ribbon.

- **Official recognition:** Awarded for service during Operation NATO Unified Protector (23 Mar–31 Oct 2011).
- **Design:** ISAF-style ribbon graphic with a bronzed metal clasp engraved "UNIFIED PROTECTOR".
- **Formats:** Available in flat regulation format and the slightly domed Elite variant.
- **Mounting options:** Can be fitted to a ribbon bar holder with rear clamps or screws, selectable at purchase.
- **Multi-place display:** Can be supplied assembled on two- or multi-place metal ribbon bars for combined display.

How to use / When it's useful

Use this ribbon to display recognized service on uniforms, in shadow boxes, or as part of a military surplus or collectors' display. It fits standard ribbon bar holders used by service personnel and collectors.

Quick answer: choose the flat or Elite variant based on your preferred look and how it will be worn or displayed. In most cases, select the mounting type (clamps or screws) that matches your existing ribbon bar or display board for easy installation.

Care and notes

Basic care and ordering notes to preserve the ribbon and ensure proper use.

- Store in a dry place away from direct sunlight to preserve fabric and clasp finish.
- Handle the bronzed clasp gently; avoid abrasive cleaning that could alter the finish.
- Confirm eligibility or personal entitlement before wearing on official uniforms.
- Limited availability: supply is restricted, so consider ordering sooner if needed.

FAQ

Q: Who is eligible to receive the Unified Protector NATO 2011 ribbon?

A: The ribbon is conferred to Aeronautica Militare personnel who completed thirty consecutive days or sixty cumulative days of honorable service during Operation NATO Unified Protector.



Q: What are the available ribbon formats?

A: Two formats are offered: the regulation flat ribbon and the slightly domed Elite variant. Choose the style that best matches your uniform or display preference.

Q: Can the ribbon be supplied mounted on a ribbon bar?

A: Yes. You can select a ribbon bar holder with rear clamps or screws. Multi-place metal bases for two or more ribbons are also available for combined displays.

Q: What does the "UNIFIED PROTECTOR" engraving signify?

A: The engraving identifies the ribbon as related to Operation NATO Unified Protector, the 2011 NATO operation that included a no-fly zone and an arms embargo to protect the civilian population.

Q: How can I be sure of the ribbon's quality?

A: The ribbon uses the ISAF-based graphic and a bronzed metal clasp. It is produced with durability in mind for display and wear, though appearance may vary slightly by format.

Q: Is the ribbon suitable for collectors as well as service members?

A: Yes. It is sought by both collectors and by service members wishing to commemorate their service during the operation. Availability may be limited.

Tip: When ordering, select the correct format (flat or Elite) and the preferred mounting type (clamps or screws). Consider multi-place ribbon bars if you plan to display multiple ribbons together and check availability before completing your purchase.
