This is a 3D rubber identification patch showing the blood group A Negative, designed for tactical, military surplus and police gear users who need quick medical identification. It attaches by rear hook-and-loop (Velcro) to uniforms, backpacks or other textile equipment.



Definition: A Negative blood type ID patch is a small, durable rubber marker that clearly displays the wearer's blood group for fast recognition in emergencies. Limited availability — add it to your kit while stock lasts.

Main features

Compact, durable and easy to attach — made for field use on uniforms and gear.

- **Material:** High-quality rubber for long-lasting wear and water resistance.
- **Attachment:** Rear hook-and-loop (Velcro) for fast, secure mounting on textile surfaces.
- **Size:** 4.5 x 2.5 cm — small and unobtrusive yet readable.
- **Design:** Raised 3D lettering and green color for clear visibility.
- **Purpose:** Immediate identification of A Negative blood type to aid first responders.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: Stick the patch onto a Velcro-compatible surface on your uniform, jacket, backpack or tactical vest. It is useful anytime you want a clear, visible medical ID on duty, during travel, or in outdoor activities.

In most cases, mount the patch where it is easily seen by medical staff or rescuers (chest, shoulder or pack strap). The Velcro allows quick removal or transfer between items as needed.

Care and notes

Simple care keeps the patch readable and secure during use.

- Clean with mild soap and water; avoid harsh chemicals to protect the rubber.
- Ensure the receiving surface has matching Velcro for a secure fit.
- Not customizable — this model is specifically marked A Negative only.
- Color: available in green only to maintain visibility on camouflage and tactical gear.

FAQ

Q: Is the patch waterproof?

A: Yes. The patch is made of water-resistant rubber and holds up in wet conditions. Normal exposure to rain or moisture will not damage it.

Q: Is the Velcro strong enough to hold during active use?

A: The rear hook-and-loop is high quality and designed to keep the patch secure on compatible textile surfaces during routine and active use.



Q: Can I use the patch on non-military clothing?

A: Yes. The patch can be attached to any garment or accessory that has a matching Velcro surface, including civilian jackets and backpacks.

Q: Is the patch available in other colors?

A: Currently this patch is offered in green only to ensure clear visibility with camouflage and tactical gear.

Q: Can I customize the patch with other information?

A: No. This product is specifically produced to show the A Negative blood group and is not customizable.

Q: What are the exact dimensions?

A: The patch measures 4.5 x 2.5 cm, a compact size that balances readability and low profile on uniforms or equipment.

Tip: Choose the correct placement and check that your gear has matching Velcro before purchase; consider browsing related tactical and military surplus items to complete your kit.
