Product short description:

The Collare da Cavaliere di Grazia dell'Ordine Costantiniano di San Giorgio is a historic ceremonial neck insignia for uniforms and formal events, intended for members of the Order or collectors of heraldic regalia.

- **Material:** Sky-blue neck ribbon with a Greek fleur-de-lis cross enamelled in crimson-purple and a gold crown enamelled red.
- **Emblem:** Cross bears the letters I.H.S.V. ("In Hoc Signo Vinces") and the christogram XP with Alpha and Omega.
- **Use:** Designed for ceremonial wear and official uniform dress.
- **Category:** Distinctive insignia for the Grazia class of the Order.

Product overview



The Collare da Cavaliere di Grazia of the Ordine Costantiniano di San Giorgio is a ceremonial neck insignia for members and representatives who follow the Order's heraldic and ceremonial rules. It is intended for formal, liturgical or representational use by those entitled to the "Grazia" category.

Definition: this item is a ceremonial neck collar — a sky-blue neck ribbon with a suspended red?purple enameled fleury (gigliata) Greek cross, bearing the traditional symbols of the Order. Sold by a specialist military surplus and tactical store, it suits ceremonial, representational and dress-duty contexts.

Main features

Carefully crafted to match the Order's heraldic tradition, the collar combines visual recognizability with ceremonial dignity.

- **Sky-blue neck ribbon** designed to be worn around the neck.
- **Red?purple enameled fleury (gigliata) Greek cross** in the traditional shape.
- **I.H.S.V.** letters on the four arms (In Hoc Signo Vinces).
- **Central cristogram XP** with **Alpha and Omega** symbols.
- **Gold crown, red?enameled** surmounting the cross to signal nobility and authority.
- Suspended cross format for clear visibility when worn over formal dress or uniform.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: wear the collar around the neck with the cross suspended centrally on the chest and the ribbon kept straight and symmetrical. In most cases, the collar is used at official ceremonies, liturgical celebrations and representative events where a formal insignia is required.

The collar is a visible heraldic element — not a daily accessory — and should be worn according to protocol for orders and chivalric insignia. It complements formal dress, uniforms and ceremonial attire used in military surplus, tactical or duty presentation contexts.

Care and notes

Store and handle the collar to preserve enamel, finishes and the ribbon; small precautions extend its life and keep the appearance formal and correct.

- Keep in a protective case to avoid scratches and impacts.
- Avoid moisture and prolonged exposure to humidity to protect metal and enamel.
- Position the ribbon symmetrically and avoid twisting when worn.
- Handle the piece by the ribbon or attachment, not by the enameled surface.

FAQ



Q: What is the Collare da Cavaliere di Grazia?

A: It is a neck insignia of the Ordine Costantiniano di San Giorgio for members of the “Grazia” category, intended for ceremonial and representational use.

Q: Who can wear the Collare da Cavaliere di Grazia?

A: The collar is for those admitted to the “Grazia” category, typically people from recognized noble lines (as defined by the Order), clergy, or those recognized for other distinguished titles.

Q: What heraldic privilege comes with this collar?

A: Members of the “Grazia” category may display the sky?blue ribbon and the Order’s cross around their personal coat of arms, starting from the third upper zone of the shield, where protocol allows.

Q: What symbols appear on the cross and what do they mean?

A: The arms bear the letters I.H.S.V. (“In Hoc Signo Vinces”), the center shows the XP cristogram with Alpha and Omega, and a red?enameled gold crown tops the cross — all traditional Costantinian symbols with theological and heraldic meaning.

Q: How should I wear the collar correctly?

A: Place the ribbon around the neck so the cross hangs centered on the chest, keep the ribbon flat and symmetrical, and ensure the piece sits properly over formal clothing or uniform.

Q: How do I care for and store the collar?

A: Store it in a protective case, avoid humidity and shocks, and clean gently if needed. Do not bend the ribbon or force the attachment, to protect enamel and fittings.

Tip: Choose the correct variant and check protocol requirements for your situation before ordering; browse related insignia, ribbons and protective cases to complete your ceremonial set in a consistent and well?presented way.
