Official Bersaglieri sabre with a gold-colored hilt (Elsa dorata), intended for collectors, ceremonial units, and historical enthusiasts. Traditional ceremonial sabre suitable for display or uniform presentation.

## Product overview

The Sciabola Ufficiale Bersaglieri con Elsa Dorata is the officer's sabre worn by Bersaglieri for armed service and with the Grande Uniforme (full dress). It is intended for serving Bersaglieri personnel and for approved ceremonial duty use.



Definition: a ceremonial military sabre with a gilded brass hilt and a slightly curved stainless steel blade. Suitable for military, tactical ceremonial, and duty applications where regulation dress is required.

### Main features

Solid construction and regulation design tailored for Bersaglieri officers. Key points at a glance:

- **Gilded brass hilt:** Five-branch hilt worked in relief for a formal appearance.
- **Slightly curved stainless steel blade:** Designed to aid extraction and ceremonial handling.
- **Scabbard included:** Protective scabbard provided for safe storage and transport.
- **Proportioned length:** Sized to match the officer's stature for comfortable carry and draw.
- **Matching dragona:** Intended to be worn with the dragona and carried at the left side.

### How to use / When it's useful

Use the sabre with the Grande Uniforme for parades, formal ceremonies, and armed service duties where regulation dress is required. It is worn on the left side and should be paired with the matching dragona.

Quick answer: the top of the grip, when sheathed and resting on the ground, should reach about 15 cm below the waist. In most cases, measure perpendicularly from the navel to the ground to calculate the correct blade length so drawing the sabre remains practical.

### Care and notes

Basic care helps keep the sabre presentation-ready and compliant with service rules.

- Wipe the blade and hilt with a soft cloth after use and store in the scabbard to protect finishes.
- Length must be proportional to the wearer's height; exceeding the recommended length can make drawing difficult.
- Product reserved for Bersaglieri personnel; civilians must show a prefectural license under art. 28 TULPS.
- Shipping only after sending a copy of military ID or specifying the barracks as the delivery address; Paypal is not accepted.

### FAQ

**Q:** Who can purchase the Sciabola Ufficiale Bersaglieri con Elsa Dorata?

**A:** The item is reserved for members of the Bersaglieri. Civilian buyers must present a prefectural license in accordance with art. 28 TULPS.



**Q:** What materials are used in the sabre?

**A:** The sabre has a gilded brass (ottone dorato) five-branch hilt and a stainless steel (acciaio Inox) blade. The scabbard is supplied with the sabre.

**Q:** How do I determine the correct length?

**A:** Measure in a straight line perpendicular from the navel to the ground. When sheathed and resting on the ground, the top of the grip should be about 15 cm below the waist.

**Q:** Can I pay with Paypal?

**A:** No. This product cannot be purchased via Paypal. Please follow the store's available payment options at checkout.

**Q:** What are the shipping requirements?

**A:** Shipment is made only after receiving a copy of the military ID or by delivering to the buyer's barracks. Civilian deliveries require a prefectural license per art. 28 TULPS.

**Q:** How should the sabre be worn during ceremonies?

**A:** The sabre is paired with the dragona and carried at the left side as part of the Grande Uniforme or during armed service duties, following unit regulations.

**Tip:** Choose the correct length variant by measuring from your navel to the ground and browse related ceremonial and duty accessories to complete your uniform set.
