## **Product short description:**

### Product overview

The Dragona Sottufficiale Marina Militare is a ceremonial sabre cord designed for non-commissioned officers of the Marina Militare. Definition: it is a double-strand cord finished with a monk's knot and a decorative bow, used as part of the officer's sabre equipment.

This accessory suits collectors, military surplus buyers, and personnel seeking authentic duty or ceremonial gear. It combines traditional styling with durable construction for long-term use.

### Main features

Traditional design and straightforward specifications make this dragona a faithful reproduction of the pattern used by Marina Militare non-commissioned officers.

- **Traditional pattern:** Made following the conventional Marina Militare design for NCO dragona.
- **Construction:** Double-strand cord gathered at two-thirds by a monk's knot (nodo da frate).
- **Finish:** Ends in a neatly tied decorative bow as shown in the original pattern.
- **Length:** Approximately 45 cm.
- **Cord diameter:** 5 mm.
- **Durability:** Built from durable materials for routine handling and display.

### How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: attach the dragona to the sabre using the monk's knot so it sits securely during ceremonial duties. In most cases, the cord is fixed at the hilt according to the traditional placement used by Marina Militare NCOs.

Use this dragona for ceremonial wear, historical displays, military surplus collections, or duty uniforms that require traditional accoutrements. It is primarily a decorative and symbolic element linked to rank and tradition.

### Care and notes

Basic care keeps the dragona looking correct and prevents wear. Handle gently and store properly between uses.

- Keep dry and store flat or hung to avoid kinks.



- Brush off dust and avoid contact with oils or solvents that could affect the cord.
- Inspect the knot and bow before use to ensure a secure fit to the sabre.
- Available in limited quantities; check stock if you need one for duty or display.

## FAQ

**Q:** What are the dimensions of the dragona?

**A:** The dragona measures approximately 45 cm in length and the cord has a diameter of 5 mm. These are intended to fit the traditional sabre setup for Marina Militare NCOs.

**Q:** What material is the dragona made from?

**A:** It is made from durable cord materials chosen for longevity and traditional appearance. The exact fiber type is not specified in the original description.

**Q:** How is the dragona attached to the sabre?

**A:** The dragona is gathered at two-thirds by a monk's knot (nodo da frate) which allows secure attachment to the sabre hilt. Ensure the knot is seated correctly for stable wear.
