## Product short description:

## Product overview

The Sciabola Ufficiali Aeronautica Militare is the official ceremonial saber for members of the Italian Air Force and qualified collectors. It is a crafted dress weapon combining a shaped black



grip with gold trim, a winged guard ending in an eagle head, and gold-relief fittings.

Definition: a ceremonial military saber issued for Aeronautica Militare officers and available to collectors with the required license. Suitable for ceremonial duty, display, military surplus collectors and tactical memorabilia.

### Main features

Carefully finished with traditional details, this saber balances presentation and historical style for parade or collection.

- **Shaped black grip:** ergonomically formed, trimmed with gold thread for comfort and a formal look.
- **Winged guard with eagle:** curved wing motif extends to the pommel and is finished with an eagle head.
- **Gold-relief metalwork:** guard, back of the grip, fittings and scabbard tip are worked in gold-tone relief.
- **Presentation length:** when sheathed and rested on the ground, the upper part of the grip sits about 10 cm below the waist.
- **Intended use:** ceremonial wear at the left side, fitted with a dragona (sword knot) and attached to a belt pendant.

### How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: worn on the left side for formal parades, duty ceremonies, and official representation. In most cases, it is part of an officer's dress kit rather than everyday wear.

Use this saber for ceremonial duty, official displays, or as a documented collector's item in a military surplus or tactical collection. It presents well when carried with the correct dragona and belt fitting.

### Care and notes

Keep the saber dry and handle it with care to preserve the gold-relief finish; normal conservation for display or ceremonial use applies.

- Store in the scabbard to protect the finish and fittings.
- Clean metal parts with a soft cloth; avoid abrasive cleaners on gold-relief areas.
- Sale reserved to Aeronautica Militare personnel or collectors with a valid ex art. 28 TULPS license.
- Purchase requires submission of a military ID copy or indication of delivery location; PayPal payments are not accepted for this product.

### FAQ



**Q:** Who can buy the Sciabola Ufficiali Aeronautica Militare?

**A:** The saber is reserved for members of the Aeronautica Militare and for collectors who hold a valid ex art. 28 TULPS license. Verification is required before sale.

**Q:** What documents are required to complete the purchase?

**A:** Buyers must submit a copy of their military ID or provide the delivery location; collectors must provide a copy of the ex art. 28 TULPS license.

**Q:** Can I pay with PayPal?

**A:** No. This product is not available for purchase via PayPal. Other payment methods will be advised at checkout.

**Q:** How long is the saber when carried?

**A:** The design places the top of the grip roughly 10 cm below the waist when sheathed and rested on the ground, ensuring a formal presentation.

**Q:** How should the saber be worn?

**A:** It is worn on the left side with a dragona (sword knot) and secured to the belt pendant for ceremonial duty or parade use.

**Q:** Is the saber an original or a reproduction?

**A:** The piece is a finished ceremonial saber with traditional craftsmanship and gold-relief details intended for official use and verified collectors; documentation is required to confirm entitlement to purchase.
