Main features

Compact, multipurpose design that reflects body heat and offers basic protection from wind and rain.

- Open size: 130 x 210 cm — large enough to cover one person fully.
- Folded/compressed size: approx. 10 cm x 7 cm x 5 mm — fits in a backpack or pocket.
- Reflective film retains and reflects body heat; also helps send visual signals to rescuers.
- Lightweight and reusable construction for multiple uses.
- Waterproof material provides a barrier against moisture and light rain; can be used as a poncho.
- Versatile: shelter, groundsheet, rain cover, or emergency signal panel.

How to use / When it's useful

Use wrapped around the body to trap heat and reduce heat loss from wind and wet conditions. In shelter situations, use as a simple tarp, poncho, or groundsheet to stay drier and warmer.

Quick answer: use it wrapped around you for heat retention or spread out as a rain shield. In most cases, it is a temporary aid — suitable for short-term protection until you reach help or better shelter.

Care and notes

Simple care keeps the blanket effective and ready for use. Store it dry and folded; avoid prolonged exposure to sharp edges or open flame.

- Fold and store dry to prevent trapping moisture and reduce odor.
- Wipe clean with a damp cloth; air dry completely before packing.
- Avoid contact with sharp objects and open flames — not fireproof.
- Inspect for tears before use; replace if the reflective layer is damaged.

FAQ

Q: How big is the blanket when folded?

A: Folded and compressed it measures approximately 10 cm x 7 cm x 5 mm, making it highly portable for packs, vehicle kits, or duty belts.

Q: Is the Emergency Thermal Blanket reusable?



A: Yes. The blanket is made from durable reflective material intended for multiple uses if handled and stored properly.

Q: Can it be worn as a poncho?

A: Yes. The reflective film can be draped or fastened as a simple poncho to provide short-term rain protection.

Q: Is the blanket waterproof?

A: The material provides a water-resistant barrier against moisture and light rain, helping to keep you drier in adverse weather.

Q: What are the open dimensions?

A: The blanket opens to 130 x 210 cm, large enough to cover an adult and useful as a groundsheet or emergency shelter.

Q: How does it help rescuers locate you?

A: The reflective surface increases visibility by reflecting light and can be used as a visual signal to attract attention from rescuers or passing units.
