Product overview

The Medaglia Terremoto Friuli is a bronze commemorative medal created to honor the rescuers who responded to the Friuli earthquake on 6 May 1976. It is intended for survivors, families, collectors of historical and military-surplus memorabilia, emergency services personnel, and museums.



Definition: a bronze commemorative medal marking the 1976 Friuli earthquake and honoring those involved in the relief efforts. This keepsake is suitable for display, commemoration events, and historical collections.

Main features

Well-crafted and symbolically detailed, the medal preserves the memory of the 1976 relief operations and offers simple customization through ribbon and size options.

- Material: bronze.
- Standard diameter: 33 mm; reduced size option: 20 mm.
- Obverse: two outstretched hands symbolizing aid and solidarity, with the bell tower of Venzone in the background.
- Reverse: circular raised inscription "Commissario Straordinario di Governo per il Friuli 1976".
- Ribbon options: blue-yellow-blue (originally assigned by Commissario Zamberletti) or a ribbon with four vertical alternating blue and yellow stripes.
- Limited stock: produced in small quantities and sought after by collectors.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: Wear or display the medal at commemorative events, keep it in a collection, or present it as a meaningful gift to someone connected to the 1976 relief efforts. It works well in shadow boxes, uniform displays, or museum cases.

In most cases, buyers choose the 33 mm size for display and the 20 mm size for a more discreet lapel or wearable option. Select the ribbon style that matches your preference or historical accuracy for display and presentation.

Care and notes

Basic care keeps the bronze looking its best and preserves the inscription and ribbon. Note the limited availability and ribbon choices when ordering.

- Keep the medal dry and store it in a soft pouch or display case to avoid scratches.
- Clean gently with a soft cloth; avoid harsh chemicals that can damage bronze or fabric ribbons.
- Choose ribbon and size at purchase—options affect appearance and wearability.
- Limited quantities mean order sooner if you want a specific variant.

FAQ

Q: What are the medal dimensions?



A: The standard medal measures 33 mm in diameter. A reduced 20 mm version is also available for a more discreet option.

Q: What material is the medal made from?

A: The medal is crafted from bronze, with raised detailing on both front and back.

Q: What ribbon options can I choose?

A: You can choose the original blue-yellow-blue ribbon (first assigned by Commissario Zamberletti) or a ribbon with four vertical alternating blue and yellow stripes.

Q: Can the medal be personalized?

A: The product offers two ribbon styles and two sizes (33 mm and 20 mm). Other personalization is not listed in the product details.

Q: Is the medal an official government award?

A: The reverse bears the inscription "Commissario Straordinario di Governo per il Friuli 1976," which references the event and office; the listing describes a commemorative medal intended to honor the 1976 relief efforts.

Q: Is the medal in stock?

A: Stock is limited. Demand is high among collectors and those connected to emergency services history, so availability can change quickly.
