The Scudetto Ricamato Friûl is an embroidered regional shield patch for people who want to show Friuli heritage on jackets, backpacks, hats or gear. It suits collectors, reenactors, and



anyone looking for a durable decorative patch.

Definition: an embroidered 8 x 7 cm shield patch with a blue background and a red eagle associated with Bertrando, Patriarch of Aquileia and Lord of Friuli.

Main features

Clear design and durable construction make this patch suitable for everyday wear or display on tactical, military surplus, and police-style gear.

- **Distinctive design:** Blue background with a red eagle for clear visual contrast.
- **Durable materials:** Made with sturdy fabric and detailed embroidery for long-lasting use.
- **Compact size:** 8 x 7 cm — noticeable but not bulky.
- **Easy to attach:** Can be sewn or glued to a variety of surfaces.
- **Limited production:** Produced in small quantities, reflecting regional interest.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: Sew or glue the patch onto jackets, backpacks, caps, uniforms, or display textiles for a regional emblem. Choose a flat, clean surface for best adhesion or stitching.

In most cases, this patch is used to show regional pride, add detail to military surplus or tactical-style clothing, or complete a collection of historical or police memorabilia. It also works well for personalizing everyday gear.

Care and notes

Basic care keeps the embroidery looking sharp and the patch secure on your gear.

- Hand-sew for the strongest attachment; use a suitable fabric adhesive if sewing is not possible.
- Avoid high-heat washing if glued; check adhesion after cleaning.
- Store flat to prevent bending or creasing of the embroidered surface.
- Not an official government or unit insignia; intended as a decorative/historic emblem.

FAQ

Q: How can I attach the Scudetto Ricamato Friûl?

A: You can sew it onto fabric for a secure hold or use a suitable fabric adhesive for quick application. Choose the method that matches the material of your item.

Q: What are the patch dimensions?



A: The patch measures 8 x 7 cm, a compact size that is visible without overpowering most garments or bags.

Q: What materials is the patch made of?

A: It is made from sturdy fabric with detailed embroidery designed for durability. The construction is intended for regular use and display.

Q: Is this an official insignia?

A: No. This item is a decorative and historic emblem representing the Friuli region, not an official government or unit insignia.

Q: Is the red eagle symbolic?

A: Yes. The red eagle references Bertrando, Patriarch of Aquileia and Lord of Friuli, and is traditionally associated with strength and regional history.

Q: Is it easy to find more of these patches?

A: Production is limited and demand can be high, so availability may vary. Check stock before planning multiple purchases.

Tip: Confirm the 8 x 7 cm size fits your intended placement before ordering, and browse related patches and mounting accessories to complete your setup without surprises.
