The Giaccone Impermeabile Esercito Anni 80/90 is an off-duty military overcoat designed for civilians, collectors, and tactical users who want authentic military surplus styling with practical weather protection. Definition: a water-repellent, olive-green cotton military coat from the 1980s–90s with removable insulation and a concealed front closure. The coat pairs historic design with functional details for everyday wear.

Main features

Built for utility and season-by-season use, this coat combines practical closures, storage and reinforcement typical of military clothing.

- **Fabric:** Water-repellent cotton in olive green for protection from rain and damp conditions.
- **Front closure:** Concealed front with green plastic buttons; the size 52 variant has a zipper.
- **Reinforced shoulders:** Padded shoulder panel with removable straps for extra support and durability.
- **Adjustable cuffs:** Velcro cuffs with a browned metal closure (pluriarma Esercito) for a custom fit.
- **Storage:** Two large front pockets for essentials and everyday carry.
- **Removable lining:** Internal polyamide fiber padding with a drawcord; detachable for use in milder weather.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: wear it as a rain-resistant outer layer in cold or wet weather, or remove the inner padding for milder seasons. The removable lining makes the coat adaptable from autumn through winter and into spring.

In most cases, use it as a durable daily jacket for outdoor work, tactical training, or as part of a military surplus or duty wardrobe. Its off-duty design fits collectors and civilians seeking an authentic look.

Care and notes

Follow basic garment care for water-repellent cotton and removable padded linings to keep the coat working and looking its best.

- Follow washing and drying instructions for water-repellent cotton and polyamide padding; remove lining before washing if required.
- **Size note:** the coat in size 52 is fitted with a zipper instead of only buttons.
- **Limited availability** — items are from a specific production period (1980s–90s) and may be in high demand.
- **Legal note:** if the coat is fitted with collar stelletta (stars), it is reserved for military personnel or collectors holding a licenza prefettizia ex art. 28 TULPS.

Q: What sizes are available?

A: Available sizes vary by stock. Check the size guidance on the product page to select the best fit for your measurements.

Q: Is this coat waterproof?

A: The coat is made of water?repellent cotton, which offers effective protection against rain and humidity but is not rated as fully waterproof like technical shell fabrics.

Q: Can I wear this coat year?round?

A: Yes. With the removable padded lining, the coat adapts to colder months when insulated and to milder weather when the lining is removed.

Q: Do I need a license to buy it?

A: No license is required for standard off?duty coats. However, if the coat has collar stelletta, it is reserved for military personnel or collectors with a licenza prefettizia ex art. 28 TULPS.

Q: How do I adjust the cuffs?

A: Cuffs adjust with Velcro and a browned metal closure (pluriarma Esercito) so you can tighten or loosen them for comfort and weather protection.

Q: What materials are used for the inner padding?

A: The internal padding is polyamide fiber with a drawcord and is removable for seasonal flexibility and easier cleaning.

Tip: Choose the right size variant (remember size 52 uses a zipper) and compare measurements before purchasing. Browse related tactical and military surplus items to complete a coordinated duty or outdoor outfit.
