## Product short description:

## Product overview

The Fregio Basco Palombari is a 45 mm burnished-metal beret badge reserved for members of the Palombari corps of the Marina Militare and for licensed collectors. Definition: a military beret



emblem identifying service in the Palombari, combining historic symbolism with a durable metal construction.

Designed for use on the basco (beret), this badge features the traditional diving helmet motif, laurel wreath and the inscription "PALOMBARI." It is suitable for service use, ceremonial wear and military surplus collections, with restricted sale and authenticity checks to meet regulations.

### Main features

Carefully crafted to reflect unit heritage while offering practical durability for duty and display.

- **Size:** 45 mm diameter, ideal for standard berets.
- **Material:** burnished metal finish for a sober, resilient appearance.
- **Design:** central diving helmet, laurel wreath and "PALOMBARI" inscription.
- **Attachment:** rear piccaglia fastener for secure mounting on the basco.
- **Use cases:** official uniform wear, ceremonial duties, tactical and military surplus collections.

### How to use / When it's useful

Attach the badge to the beret using the rear piccaglia fastener so it sits centered above the left eyebrow, as standard for Italian naval berets. Quick answer: it is worn on the basco to show unit affiliation during service and formal occasions.

In most cases, the badge is issued to serving Palombari and may be purchased by verified collectors under law. Use it for daily duty, parades, or to complete a military surplus or tactical uniform display while observing purchase restrictions and authenticity checks.

### Care and notes

Maintain the badge's finish and attachment for long-term use; follow these simple care and legal notes.

- Keep clean with a soft cloth; avoid harsh chemicals that may damage the burnished finish.
- Check the piccaglia fastening regularly to ensure the badge remains secure on the beret.
- Sale restricted: purchase is reserved for Palombari personnel or collectors with a prefectural license under art. 28 TULPS.
- Required documentation: copy of military ID or specified barracks address for verification at purchase.

### FAQ

**Q:** Who can buy the Fregio Basco Palombari?

**A:** The badge is reserved for serving Palombari of the Marina Militare and for collectors holding a



prefectoral license compliant with art. 28 TULPS. Sales are verified before shipment.

**Q:** What documents are needed to complete the purchase?

**A:** You must upload a copy of your military ID card or provide the barracks address where delivery will be accepted. These documents are used to confirm entitlement.

**Q:** Is the badge durable for operational use?

**A:** Yes. The badge is made in burnished metal designed to resist wear in normal service conditions, though routine care is recommended to preserve the finish.

**Q:** Can the badge be delivered to a barracks address?

**A:** Yes. During order registration you can specify delivery to your barracks; this option supports the verification process and secure delivery.

**Q:** Are collectors allowed to purchase this badge?

**A:** Collectors may buy it only if they present a valid prefectoral license as required by art. 28 TULPS. The seller will verify the license before completing the sale.

**Q:** How can I verify the authenticity of the badge?

**A:** Each badge is supplied with seller assurance of quality and authenticity. Verification is part of the purchase process to ensure compliance with regulations and unit standards.
