Product description:

Product overview

The Sciabola Sottufficiale Artiglieria e Cavalleria is a ceremonial service sword designed for non-commissioned officers in artillery and cavalry units; a Maresciallo variant follows the same style with similar fittings. This product is intended for military personnel (Esercito) and qualified collectors who meet legal requirements.

Definition: a traditionally styled military sword with a slightly curved blade and protective guard,



built for ceremonial and duty use in military and tactical contexts. It suits collectors, ceremonial duty, and military surplus buyers looking for authentic gear.

Main features

Built for balance, durability and formal wear, the sword combines classic styling with practical construction for duty and display.

- **Guard:** slightly wider guard for improved hand protection.
- **Cap:** semicylindrical cap (cappetta) for traditional appearance.
- **Grip:** smooth handle for secure, comfortable hold.
- **Blade:** wide, slightly curved blade in AISI 420 steel for rust resistance and durability.
- **Fit:** regulated length for correct wear and extraction when carried in the scabbard.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: use this sword primarily for ceremonial duty, parades, and formal military wear where regulation swords are required. It is not intended for combat use.

In most cases, the sword is worn on the left side and secured to belt straps; when placed in its scabbard and set on the ground, the top of the grip should reach about 15 cm (approx. 6 in) below the wearer's waist to meet standard fit rules. It also serves as an authentic piece for military surplus collectors and tactical display.

Care and notes

Basic care keeps the AISI 420 blade and fittings serviceable and presentable; follow legal requirements for ownership and transport.

- Keep the blade clean and lightly oiled to limit corrosion; wipe before storing.
- Store in the scabbard in a dry place away from prolonged humidity.
- Handle with care—this is a bladed weapon; follow local rules and unit regulations when displaying or transporting.
- Sale is restricted: proof of military service or a prefectural license (art. 28 TULPS) is required for collectors.

FAQ

Q: Who can buy the Sciabola Sottufficiale Artiglieria e Cavalleria?

A: Purchase is reserved for members of the Esercito and for collectors who hold a valid prefectural license in accordance with art. 28 TULPS. Documentation must be provided before sale.



Q: What documents are required to complete an order?

A: You must send a copy of your military ID card or a service attestation. Collectors must provide a copy of the prefectural license. Delivery can be arranged to the service command address when registering.

Q: What is the blade made of?

A: The blade is manufactured in AISI 420 steel, selected for strength and corrosion resistance suitable for ceremonial use and long-term display.

Q: How is the sword length regulated?

A: Length is regulated so the top of the grip, with the sword in its scabbard placed on the ground, reaches about 15 cm (approx. 6 in) below the waist. The sword must be proportioned to the wearer and worn on the left side.

Q: Is this sword suitable for tactical or police use?

A: This is a ceremonial service sword intended for military dress and collectors; it is not a tactical tool for police operations. It is appropriate for display in military surplus or duty collections.

Q: What maintenance is recommended?

A: Regularly clean and oil the blade, inspect fittings for wear, and store dry. Follow unit and legal rules when transporting or presenting the sword.

Tip: Choose the variant and size that match your rank and fit requirements, and browse related ceremonial and military surplus items to complete your uniform or collection.
