Product overview

The Fregio Gala Berretto Maschile Dragoni Ricamato a Mano is a hand-embroidered dress cap badge made for the Cavalleria Dragoni male gala uniform. It is intended for serving members, collectors, and uniform suppliers who need an authentic, dress-cap insignia.



Definition: a hand-stitched gold-wire badge on black cloth, sized for formal male caps. Also of interest for military surplus, ceremonial duty, police or tactical display and collection.

Main features

Carefully crafted with traditional techniques, this badge combines visible detail with a compact size suitable for formal headgear.

- **Hand embroidery:** Stitched by hand for refined detail and quality not achievable by standard machine work.
- **Gold wire on black cloth:** Cantutiglia oro embroidery on black panno for the traditional look of the Cavalleria Dragoni.
- **Designed for Cavalleria Dragoni:** Pattern and proportions match the unit's gala berretto style.
- **Compact dimensions:** 3.5 cm width x 9 cm height, sized for male dress caps without appearing oversized.
- **Easy to fit:** Made for straightforward application to the berretto following unit guidelines.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: attach the badge to the front of the male gala cap for the Cavalleria Dragoni to complete the formal uniform. Follow your unit's uniform regulations for exact placement.

In most cases, the badge can be fitted by simple stitching or by a uniform tailor; if you are unsure, ask your quartermaster or an experienced uniform service. Use it for parade, ceremonial duty, displays, or as a collector's piece.

Care and notes

Handle and store the badge carefully to preserve the metal thread and cloth. Limited quantities are available because each piece is hand-embroidered.

- Store flat in a dry place to avoid crushing the embroidery.
- Avoid exposure to moisture and abrasive contact to protect shine and stitching.
- Clean only with gentle, specialist care—do not machine wash.
- Note: availability is limited due to the time-intensive handwork.

FAQ

Q: What are the badge dimensions?

A: The badge measures 3.5 cm wide by 9 cm high. These dimensions are suited to standard male gala caps.



Q: Is this badge compatible with all male berets or caps?

A: It is designed for the Cavalleria Dragoni male gala berretto. Compatibility with other caps depends on cap design and unit rules.

Q: How is the badge attached to the cap?

A: The badge is intended for easy attachment; common methods include hand-stitching or professional fitting by a uniform tailor. Follow your unit's instructions.

Q: Does the hand embroidery last longer than machine embroidery?

A: Hand embroidery offers fine detail and robust stitching. Proper care and correct attachment will help maintain appearance over time.

Q: Are there other color or material variants available?

A: This item is currently offered in cantutiglia oro on black cloth, in keeping with Cavalleria Dragoni tradition.

Q: Is the badge frequently in stock?

A: Stock is limited because each piece is hand-embroidered. If you need one for an event, order early to avoid delays.

Tip: Choose the correct placement and confirm sizing with your unit before ordering. Browse related uniform accessories to complete your gala outfit or to find matching items for collection or display.
