combines a compact profile with a realistic look, making it suitable for display or controlled simulation use.

Definition: A blank-firing Derringer is a small, non-lethal firearm replica that fires blank (6 mm) cartridges to produce sound and muzzle flash without firing live projectiles.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: Use this Derringer as a collectible, a prop in stage productions, or a simulation tool in controlled training settings; it is not a live firearm. It is particularly useful where a compact, period-accurate blank-firing pistol is needed.

In most cases, the pistol is best used for display, historical reenactments, theatrical scenes, film props, and non-lethal training drills. Tactical and police-themed displays or military surplus collections also benefit from its authentic look and compact size.

Care and notes

Basic care and precautions help maintain appearance and safe use.

- Store unloaded and in a secure place away from children; treat it with the same handling caution as a real firearm.
- Regularly clean the barrels and moving parts after use to prevent residue buildup from blanks.
- Use only 6 mm blank cartridges specified for blank-firing pistols; do not attempt to fire live ammunition.
- Although the product is listed for free sale under the cited Ministero note, always verify local



laws and venue rules before use.

Q: Is this pistol legal to buy?

A: Yes. The Pistola a Salve Derringer 6 mm. is listed for free sale according to Ministero dell'Interno note n. 559/C 50.299--93 of 8/11/95. Check local regulations where you live or intend to use it.

Q: What are the pistol's dimensions and weight?

A: The pistol measures 12.5 cm in width and weighs 360 grams, making it compact and lightweight for display or handling.

Q: Does the pistol fire real bullets?

A: No. It is a blank-firing (salve) pistol designed to use 6 mm blank cartridges, producing sound and flash but not firing live projectiles.

Q: What material and finish does it have?

A: The Derringer has a chrome-plated finish with black trigger, grips and opening lever; it is built from materials described as high quality for durability.

Q: Is it suitable for historical reenactments or theater?

A: Yes. Its realistic design and blank-firing operation make it suitable for stage productions, film, and reenactments when used following safety protocols.

Q: How many shots does it hold before reloading?

A: The break-action Derringer has two stacked barrels, so it fires two blank cartridges before needing to be reloaded.
