Mostrine Farmacisti are a pair of enamelled Army insignia intended for serving military pharmacists and authorised collectors. Definition: a pair of enamelled pharmacist insignia featuring a maroon single-point flame and a gold caduceus emblem.



These insignia signal professional affiliation within the Army and are suitable for duty uniforms, display, or curated military surplus collections. Keywords: military pharmacist insignia, enamelled insignia, duty/tactical gear.

Main features

High-quality enamel and metal construction, with clear symbolism and limited availability reserved for authorised personnel and collectors.

- **Distinctive design:** maroon single-point flame with a gold caduceus (winged staff with two snakes).
- **Pair included:** sold as a matching set (two mostrine).
- **Materials:** enamel finish with gold-coloured metal detailing for lasting appearance.
- **Reserved supply:** issued only to Army personnel or collectors with required documentation.
- **Tradition and symbolism:** represents the pharmacist role and an historic symbol of peace and prosperity.

How to use / When it's useful

These mostrine are intended to be worn as official insignia by Army pharmacists or kept as authenticated collector items. Use them for uniform identification, ceremonial wear, or adding to a verified military surplus collection.

Quick answer: They are for serving Army pharmacy personnel and authorised collectors only. In most cases, we will ship only after verifying military ID or a prefectural licence under art. 28 TULPS for collectors.

Care and notes

Keep the enamel and metal clean and store the pair in a dry place to preserve finish and colour.

- Do not use abrasive cleaners; wipe gently with a soft, dry or slightly damp cloth.
- Sale and shipment require verification: military ID for Army personnel or prefectural licence (art. 28 TULPS) for collectors.
- Limited stock: availability is restricted and subject to document verification before dispatch.

FAQ

Q: Who can purchase the Mostrine Farmacisti?

A: The insignia are reserved for Army military personnel and collectors who provide a valid prefectural licence under art. 28 TULPS.



Q: What materials are the insignia made from?

A: They are enamelled with gold-coloured metal detailing, designed for durability and a polished appearance.

Q: How is shipping handled?

A: Shipping occurs only after identification: military staff must submit a military ID, or collectors must provide the required licence. Shipments can be sent to the registered Command if requested.

Q: Can a civilian buy these mostrine?

A: No. Only serving Army personnel or authorised collectors with the correct documentation may purchase them.

Q: What symbol appears on the mostrine?

A: The insignia feature the caduceus — a winged staff with two intertwined snakes — combined with a maroon single-point flame, symbolising the pharmacist role.

Q: Are these sold individually or as a pair?

A: They are sold as a pair of mostrine and supplied together to ensure a matching set for uniform or collection purposes.
