Product overview

The Collare di Cavaliere di Merito dell'Ordine Costantiniano di San Giorgio is a ceremonial neck order for members, collectors, and officers who participate in formal events and presentations. It



is intended for ceremonial use, collectors of orders, and duty or police ceremonial units seeking authentic insignia.

Definition: this is a neck collarette featuring the red enamel Greek cross of the Sacred Military Constantinian Order of Saint George, mounted on a blue striped ribbon with ties. The piece is crafted for presentation and wear at official ceremonies; availability is limited and stock may be reserved for verified orders.

Main features

Key characteristics and visible details of the collarette:

- **Recognizable cross:** Greek-shaped cross with red/purple enamel and central XP christogram.
- **Historic lettering:** I.H.S.V. (In Hoc Signo Vinces) on the four arms and Greek letters Alpha and Omega on the cross arms.
- **Ribbon and ties:** Blue striped ribbon, 5 cm wide, with matching ties to secure the collar at the neck.
- **Ceremonial fit:** Designed specifically in a collar variant for correct presentation during official events.
- **Quality materials:** Made with enamel and fine fabrics to maintain appearance and durability.
- **Certificate:** Each collar is supplied with a certificate of authenticity confirming origin and quality.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: wear the collarette around the neck, tying the ribbon ties at the back for a secure, ceremonial fit. It is worn for formal ceremonies, investitures, parades, displays, and by collectors when exhibiting orders.

In most cases, the collar variant provides the correct posture and presentation for official use; collectors and reenactors also use it for display or period-accurate uniforms. For duty or police ceremonial units, it complements formal dress during protocol events or honors ceremonies.

Care and notes

Simple care preserves the finish and textiles and helps maintain the certificate and presentation box if provided.

- Store flat or on a padded form to prevent creasing of the ribbon.
- Clean gently with a soft cloth; avoid abrasive cleaners on enamel and fabrics.
- Keep the certificate in a dry place to preserve provenance and resale value.
- Note: customization is not available for this item.



FAQ

Q: What are the shipping times?

A: Shipping is generally 5–7 business days. We use secure packaging to protect the collar during transit.

Q: Will the collar fit all neck sizes?

A: Yes. The collar uses adjustable ties on the ribbon to provide a comfortable, secure fit for most sizes.

Q: Can I personalize or customize the collar?

A: At this time we do not offer customization for this item; the collarette is supplied in the official collar variant only.

Q: What materials are used?

A: The collar is produced with enamel on the cross and fine fabrics for the ribbon, consistent with traditional ceremonial insignia.

Q: How can I verify authenticity?

A: Each collar is issued with a certificate of authenticity that documents its origin and quality. Keep this certificate with the item.

Q: Is this suitable for military surplus or tactical collections?

A: Yes. Collectors of military surplus, ceremonial gear, and duty equipment often add such collarettes to their collections for display or protocol use.
