Product overview

This product is a pair of enamel collar badges for the Italian Army Lagunari amphibious troops, intended for serving personnel and authorised collectors. They are designed to identify and honor the Lagunari corps while fitting standard uniforms.



Definition: A pair of red-enamel Lapel/collar badges with a rear clamp attachment, featuring the lion of San Marco, crossed rifles and an anchor. Ideal for military insignia collectors, tactical uniform use, or military surplus displays.

Main features

Compact, durable insignia with historic symbols and a secure fixing system. These badges balance visibility and uniform etiquette for duty wear or collection display.

- **High-quality materials:** Enamel finish with metal base for long-lasting appearance.
- **Secure attachment:** Rear clamp (morsetto) keeps each badge firmly fixed to the uniform.
- **Distinctive design:** Red enamel field with a five-point silver star and upper motif of the lion of San Marco over two crossed rifles and an anchor.
- **Size:** 4.7 cm height x 2.5 cm length — balanced for elegance and visibility.
- **Sold as a pair:** One pair of badges suitable for both collar points or lapels.
- **Suitable contexts:** Military duty insignia, tactical uniform presentation, or military surplus collections.

How to use / When it's useful

Use these badges on the collar or lapel of the appropriate uniform according to unit regulations. They are useful whenever official insignia are required for identification, ceremonial wear, or display in a collection.

Quick answer: Wear on the uniform collar or lapel using the rear clamp for a secure fit. In most cases, purchase and use must follow the corps' rules and the legal requirements for collectors.

Care and notes

Simple care preserves the enamel and metal finish; handle clamps carefully to avoid bending. Note the legal restrictions on sale and ownership described below.

- Wipe with a soft, dry or slightly damp cloth; avoid abrasive cleaners and solvents.
- Check the clamp before wear to ensure a secure fit and avoid loss during active duty.
- Sale is restricted: buyers who are serving Lagunari must provide a copy of military ID or register with delivery to their unit.
- Collectors must provide a prefectural licence under art. 28 TULPS to purchase.

FAQ

Q: Who can buy the Mostrine Lagunari?

A: These badges are reserved for members of the Lagunari corps and for collectors who hold a prefectural licence (ex art. 28 TULPS). Purchase requires identity and licence verification.



Q: What are the exact dimensions?

A: Each badge measures 4.7 cm in height and 2.5 cm in length. They are sold as a matching pair for both sides of the uniform.

Q: How do the badges attach to the uniform?

A: Each badge uses a rear clamp (morsetto) for a robust attachment. Ensure the clamp is fully closed to prevent movement or loss during wear.

Q: What symbols appear on the badge?

A: The upper motif shows the lion of San Marco over two crossed rifles and an anchor, with a five-point silver star on a red enamel background—symbols tied to Lagunari tradition.

Q: Are these original issue items or reproductions?

A: The listing describes enamel badges produced for use by the Lagunari; buyers should consult unit supply rules or seller verification for specifics about issue status.

Q: What documentation is needed to complete a purchase?

A: Serving personnel must send a copy of their military ID or register with the site indicating the delivery address as their command. Collectors must submit the prefectural licence required by art. 28 TULPS.
