Wear it for museum-style displays, stage or film costume, living history events, and collector showcases. The cap fits like a traditional peaked cap and is intended to complement other military surplus or historical uniform items.

Care and notes

Simple care keeps the cap looking its best; treat it as a delicate, handcrafted garment rather than everyday head protection.

- Hand-clean or spot-clean wool and leather areas; avoid machine washing.
- Allow up to 30 working days for production due to artisanal manufacturing.
- Not a certified safety or ballistic helmet—do not use for protection in tactical or duty scenarios.
- Store in a dry place away from prolonged moisture or direct sunlight to preserve materials.

Q: What material is the cap made of?



A: The cap is made from heavy wool with a white wool trim and leather finish on the edge. Metal parts are finished in a silver tone.

Q: What is a "visiera mezza bulgara" (half-Bulgarian visor)?

A: It is a rigid, half-style visor that keeps the cap's front shape, provides sun shading, and gives the cap a formal, authoritative silhouette.
