Product overview

Mostrine Lagunari Carristi are a pair of enamel screw-back rank insignia made for members of the Lagunari Carristi corps and for qualified collectors. They reproduce the corps symbols and are intended for wear on uniforms, ceremonial duty, or as part of a regulated military collection.

Definition: these are red-enameled metal collar badges (pair) with a rear screw attachment, sized



for uniform display. Keywords: military insignia, tactical insignia, military surplus duty gear.

Main features

Well-finished enamel badges that follow the traditional Carristi emblem and are supplied as a pair with secure screw attachments.

- **Design:** Red enamel upper area with the Lion of San Marco over two rifles and an anchor; lower area shows a silver five-point star and a two-flame red emblem on blue.
- **Material:** High-quality enamel over metal for long-lasting finish and color retention.
- **Attachment:** Rear screw fastener for secure mounting on uniform collars or suitable tactical garments.
- **Size:** 4.7 cm height x 2.5 cm width (pair).
- **Availability:** Limited quantities reserved to corps members and licensed collectors under art. 28 TULPS.
- **Authenticity check:** Sale requires submission of a military ID copy or site registration with your service command for verification.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: wear these mostrine on the uniform collar or use them as certified collectible insignia once eligibility is verified. They fit standard uniform placement for Carristi collar badges.

In most cases, members of the Lagunari Carristi will use them for duty, parade, or ceremonial uniforms; licensed collectors use them for protected collections or display. Attach the pair with the screw backs and check tightness to avoid loss.

Care and notes

Keep the badges clean and dry to preserve the enamel and metal finish; handle the screw backs carefully to avoid stripping.

- Wipe with a soft, dry cloth; avoid abrasive cleaners or strong solvents.
- Check the screw fasteners periodically to ensure a secure fit on fabric.
- Sale restricted: purchase requires military ID or a registered service command for delivery, or a prefectural license (art. 28 TULPS) for collectors.
- Limited stock: availability may be restricted to qualified buyers and verified collectors.

FAQ

Q: Who is allowed to buy Mostrine Lagunari Carristi?

A: These badges are reserved for members of the Lagunari Carristi and for collectors who hold a prefectural license under art. 28 TULPS. Verification is required before sale.



Q: What are the exact dimensions of the badges?

A: The pair measures 4.7 cm in height and 2.5 cm in width each. Dimensions are provided for correct placement on uniforms.

Q: What materials are used in these mostrine?

A: They are metal badges finished with high-quality red enamel. The enamel provides color durability and resistance under normal use.

Q: How do you verify eligibility to purchase?

A: You must send a copy of your military ID or register on the site indicating your service command as the delivery point. Collectors must provide a copy of their prefectural license (art. 28 TULPS).

Q: Can I wear these on civilian clothing or only on uniform?

A: They are designed for uniform use and ceremonial display, but verified owners may also keep them in a collection or display case according to applicable rules.

Q: What if I need proof of authenticity for a collection?

A: Authentication is handled through the required verification documents at purchase (military ID or prefectural license) and by registering the service command when requested.
