## Product short description:

The Fregio Basco Infermiere Volontarie is a beret badge that honors the dedication of volunteer nurses. It's intended for uniform wearers, collectors, and anyone seeking a respectful emblem that recognizes voluntary nursing service.

## Product overview

The Fregio Basco Infermiere Volontarie is a metal beret badge made for volunteer nurses who



wear the traditional nurse's basco (beret). It adds a professional emblem to uniforms used in duty, ceremonial, or field support roles.

**Definition:** a metal insignia showing the red cross motif and the inscription "II.VV Infermiere Volontarie" designed to attach to a nurse's beret. Suitable for uniformed medical volunteers, collectors of military surplus insignia, and tactical/duty uniform users.

### Main features

Compact, durable, and symbolic—this beret badge combines traditional design with practical attachment for everyday use.

- **Symbolic design:** Laurel fronds, a turreted crown and a red cross on white enamel, with the cartiglio reading "II.VV Infermiere Volontarie".
- **Size:** 4.5 x 6 cm, made to fit standard nurse berets.
- **Attachment:** Rear prong fastener (piccaglia) for secure mounting.
- **Durability:** Made from quality metal and enamel to resist wear during regular use.
- **Use cases:** Ideal for duty uniforms, ceremonial wear, and collectors of military surplus or police/tactical insignia.

### How to use / When it's useful

Attach the badge by pushing the rear prongs through the beret fabric and folding or securing them on the inside to lock the insignia in place. It is designed to remain stable during normal activities.

**Quick answer:** Use it on your volunteer nurse beret for identification, pride, or ceremonial dress. In most cases, it is suitable for daily wear and formal occasions where a uniformed medical emblem is required.

### Care and notes

Keep the badge looking its best with simple care and correct mounting to avoid damage to the beret or the insignia.

- Wipe gently with a soft, dry cloth after use; avoid abrasive cleaners and strong solvents.
- Check the prongs are correctly folded or secured inside the beret to prevent loss.
- Inspect periodically for enamel chips or loose fittings and re-secure as needed.

### FAQ

**Q:** What are the badge dimensions?

**A:** The badge measures 4.5 x 6 cm, a size intended to suit standard nurse berets without



overpowering the headwear.

**Q:** How is the badge attached to the beret?

**A:** It uses a rear prong fastener (piccaglia). Insert the prongs through the beret fabric and secure them on the inside to hold the badge in place.

**Q:** What material is the badge made from?

**A:** The badge is metal with enamel detailing. It is produced to resist normal wear, preserving the colors and finish under typical use.

**Q:** Will it fit all types of berets?

**A:** It is designed for volunteer nurse berets; it should fit most standard beret fabrics. Verify fabric thickness and secure attachment to ensure proper fit.

**Q:** Can I order this badge in bulk?

**A:** Availability can be limited; if you need multiple units, check current stock at purchase and consider contacting the seller about larger orders.

**Q:** How should I store the badge when not in use?

**A:** Store in a dry, cool place away from direct sunlight. Keep it separate from sharp objects to prevent enamel scratches or metal dents.

**Tip:** Choose the correct badge and check the beret fabric before mounting; consider browsing related uniform insignia and accessories to complete the look without rushing your selection.
