**Definition:** an officially styled regimental insignia set measuring 2.4 cm wide by 3 cm high with a clip attachment, suitable for uniform display, collection, or tactical/military surplus displays.

### Main features

Clear, collectible insignia that reflects the unit's history and honours.

- **Authentic set:** Enamel shoulder boards (mostrine) and infantry badge with the 152° numeral.

### Care and notes

Handle and store the enamel insignia carefully to keep colours and the clip in good condition.

- Clean gently with a soft, dry cloth; avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Secure the clip when wearing to prevent loss; avoid bending the attachment.
- Store separately to prevent scratches to the enamel finish.
- Limited availability: stock is produced in small quantities, so availability may be restricted.

**Q:** What are the exact dimensions?

**A:** The insignia measures 2.4 cm in width and 3 cm in height. The measurements refer to each individual piece in the set.



**Q:** What does the set include?

**A:** The set includes enamel shoulder boards (mostrine smaltate) and an infantry badge (fregio di fanteria) with the numeral for the 152° Reggimento Fanteria Sassari.

**Q:** Where is the 152° Reggimento Fanteria Sassari based?

**A:** The regiment is stationed in Sassari and is maintained with volunteer personnel.

**Q:** What decorations does the unit have?

**A:** The regimental War Flag (Bandiera di Guerra) is decorated with an Ordine Militare d'Italia and two Medaglie d'Oro al Valor Militare, reflecting the unit's recognised valor.

**Q:** When is the regiment's celebration day?

**A:** The regiment's anniversary is celebrated on 28 January, commemorating the combats at Col del Rosso and Col d'Echele in 1918.

**A:** The items have a clip (attacco a morsetto) for easy attachment to uniform fabric or mounting surfaces; ensure the clip is secure to avoid accidental loss.
