## Product short description:

## Product overview

The Fregio Basco Ufficiale Medico Esercito is a metal beret badge designed for Italian Army medical officers, also suitable for collectors, military surplus sellers, and tactical gear or duty



uniform users. It identifies medical personnel and complements standard beret uniforms.

**Definition:** a metal beret emblem worn on the beret to indicate membership in the army medical corps.

### Main features

Clean, durable design that reproduces the traditional medical officer emblem and fits standard berets used by the Italian Army.

- **Distinctive design:** five-point star within a circular ring, topped by a turreted crown, with a white enamel disk and red cross at the center, flanked by two caducei.
- **Durable metal construction:** built to keep shape and finish under normal use.
- **Diameter:** 6 cm, clearly visible without being bulky.
- **Rear piccaglia attachment:** secure rear fastening (piccaglia style) for stable mounting on a beret.
- **Uniform compatibility:** designed to match standard Italian Army berets and uniform placement.
- **Suitable for:** military surplus collectors, tactical/duty uniforms, and display pieces.

### How to use / When it's useful

**Quick answer:** attach the badge to the beret using the rear piccaglia fastener so the emblem sits centered and stable on the front of the beret. Ensure the pin is fully secured through the beret fabric.

In most cases, this fregio is used on service berets or as a replacement badge for medical officers, collectors, and display uniforms. It is also useful for tactical kit displays and military surplus inventory where authentic-looking insignia are required.

### Care and notes

Basic care extends the badge's appearance and fastening reliability—keep it clean and check the attachment before wearing.

- Wipe with a soft, dry cloth; avoid abrasive cleaners or strong chemicals that could affect the finish.
- Check the piccaglia fastener before each use to prevent loss; tighten or reposition if needed.
- Store in a dry place to prevent corrosion or discoloration.
- Availability is limited; verify stock quantity before placing large orders.

### FAQ



**Q:** What are the badge dimensions?

**A:** The badge has a diameter of 6 cm. This size is intended to be visible on the front of a standard beret without being oversized.

**Q:** How does the badge attach to a beret?

**A:** It uses a rear piccaglia attachment (a fixed pin-style fastener) that secures the badge to the beret fabric. Ensure the pin is fully inserted and held firmly in place.

**Q:** What material is the badge made from?

**A:** The badge is made of sturdy metal designed for durability under normal use. Treat it gently to preserve the finish.

**Q:** Is this badge compatible with all berets?

**A:** It is designed for standard Italian Army berets. It will generally fit other standard beret styles, but check fit on non-standard or custom berets before long-term use.

**Q:** Can I buy this badge in bulk?

**A:** Bulk purchases may be possible but depend on current stock levels. Because availability can be limited, confirm quantities before placing a large order.

**Q:** Is this the official army-issued badge?

**A:** The product is sold under the name Fregio Basco Ufficiale Medico Esercito and reproduces the medical officer emblem. For questions about official issue status, contact the appropriate military authorities.
