Main features

In most cases, secure the badge with the clamp-style fastener; press the clamp firmly to the fabric and check the hold before use. For collectors, use a small display case or frame to protect the finish and keep the badge visible.

Care and notes

Keep the badge in good condition with simple, gentle care and mindful storage.

- Clean with a soft, dry cloth; avoid abrasive cleaners or strong chemicals that can damage the plating.
- Store in a dry place or a small display case to prevent scratches and tarnish.
- Check the clamp fastener before wearing to ensure it remains secure.
- Limited availability: consider purchasing more than one if you want a wearable piece and a display copy.

Q: What are the badge dimensions?

A: The badge has a diameter of 2.5 cm. It is compact and designed to be unobtrusive when worn



or displayed.
