The Distintivo Ricordo SFOR Bosnia NATO is a 2.4 cm commemorative metal badge for collectors, veterans, and history enthusiasts who value NATO mission memorabilia. It is ideal for military surplus collectors, tactical gear displays, and anyone preserving a record of Italian service in Bosnia under NATO.



Definition: a small, silvered, bronzed metal badge that commemorates the Italian contribution to the SFOR (Stabilization Force) mission in Bosnia. This piece combines historic symbolism with a compact design suited for display or collection.

In most cases, collectors place it in display cases, on a lapel board, or within a veteran's memorabilia collection to preserve the memory of the SFOR mission (1996–2004). It is also appropriate as a thoughtful gift for those connected to the mission or interested in military history.

Care and notes

Simple care will keep the badge in good condition; handle it gently due to its small size and metal finish.

- Store dry and avoid prolonged exposure to moisture to limit tarnishing.
- Clean gently with a soft, dry cloth; avoid abrasive cleaners that can damage the finish.
- Because the badge is small (2.4 cm), keep out of reach of young children to prevent choking risk.
- Availability may be limited — check current stock if you are completing a collection.
