How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: Use this pistol with 8 mm blank cartridges only and follow all safety procedures. It provides realistic handling for drills, theatrical work, and safe simulation exercises.

In most cases, this model is chosen by collectors who want a visually accurate piece, instructors running force-on-force or training drills, and production teams needing a realistic prop. It is also suitable for display in a military surplus or duty-equipment collection.

Care and notes

Basic care keeps the pistol reliable and maintains its appearance; observe legal and safety guidance even though it is a free-sale item under the stated ministry note.

- Store in the supplied plastic case to protect finish and components.
- Clean and inspect the slide and magazine after use to remove residue from blank cartridges.
- Always handle as if it were a live firearm and follow local safety rules and range regulations.
- Check local laws and restrictions before purchase or use, despite the national note on free sale.

FAQ

Q: Is the Beretta 85 blank pistol legal to buy?

A: According to the Ministry of the Interior note n. 559/C 50.299--93 dated 8/11/95 it is a free-sale



product. Local rules may vary, so check regional or municipal regulations before purchase.

Q: What caliber does it use?

A: The pistol is designed for 8 mm blank cartridges. Do not attempt to use live ammunition or cartridges of a different caliber.

Q: Does it have a moving slide?

A: Yes, it features a slide-action (moving slide) to simulate realistic cycling for training and handling practice.

Q: How many rounds does the magazine hold?

A: The removable magazine holds up to 8 rounds, which supports longer practice sessions without frequent reloads.

Q: Is a transport case included?

A: Yes, the pistol is supplied with a plastic case for secure storage and transport.

Q: What are the weight and size?

A: The pistol weighs 860 g and has an overall length of 170 mm. It is semi-automatic and fitted with a manual safety for controlled handling.
