Main features

How to use / When it's useful

The medal is mainly a collectible or commemorative item: suitable for display, preservation in a collection, or as a personal tribute to service during the Etna emergency. It is also appropriate as a gift to veterans, emergency responders, or family members wishing to honor service.

Quick answer: use it for display, commemoration, or as part of a medal collection. In most cases, buyers treat this as a keepsake or historical piece rather than routine wear.

Care and notes

Store and care for the medal to preserve its finish and inscriptions. Handle gently and avoid harsh chemicals.

- Keep in a dry, padded box or display case to prevent scratches and tarnish.
- Clean gently with a soft cloth; avoid abrasive or acidic cleaners that could damage the burnished silver finish.
- Do not expose to prolonged moisture or chemicals (perfume, cleaning agents).
- Note the limited availability when purchasing; stock may be restricted due to demand and
