Product overview

The **Fregio Basco Carristi** is a beret badge for members of the Carristi specialty of the Italian Army, designed to be worn on the service beret as a sign of membership and duty. It is intended for active personnel and collectors who meet the purchase requirements.



Definition: a matte silvered metal beret emblem reserved for personnel of the Carristi corps. The badge combines traditional military symbolism with a secure rear piccaglia fastening for reliable wear. **Keywords:** beret badge, military badge, tactical, military surplus.

Main features

Clear, durable construction and a recognisable Carristi design make this badge suitable for official wear and display.

- **Material:** matte silvered metal for long-lasting appearance.
- **Design:** enclosed in a ring, it shows a straight flame with a central dischetto (regimental disk) between a crossed cannon and machine gun, with a tank below.
- **Attachment:** rear piccaglia fastening for secure application to the beret.
- **Exclusivity:** sale reserved to members of the Carristi corps upon verification.
- **Symbolic value:** worn as a sign of belonging and service to the unit.

How to use / When it's useful

Affix the badge to the beret using the rear piccaglia fastening so it sits securely on the headgear. Follow your unit's dress rules when wearing the emblem for duty or ceremonial occasions.

Quick answer: attach via the piccaglia fitting and ensure alignment with service regulations. In most cases, you will need to provide proof of belonging (military ID or barracks delivery) before purchase is completed.

Care and notes

Care for the badge to preserve its finish and keep it suited for official use.

- Clean gently with a soft, dry cloth; avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals.
- Remove the badge before washing the beret or storing it with damp items.
- Sale and delivery require proof of Carristi membership (military ID or barracks address).
- Orders may be processed only after verification of eligibility.

FAQ

Q: Who can purchase the Fregio Basco Carristi?

A: Purchase is limited to members of the Carristi corps of the Italian Army. Orders require verification of service before shipment.

Q: What material is the badge made of?

A: The badge is made of matte silvered metal, chosen for durability and a professional



appearance.

Q: How is the badge attached to the beret?

A: It uses a rear piccaglia fastening that secures the badge to the beret. Fit it according to your unit's dress guidance.

Q: Can non-Carristi buy this badge?

A: No. The sale is reserved exclusively for Carristi personnel and requires proof of membership before the order is completed.

Q: How can I prove my membership in the Carristi corps?

A: Provide a copy of your military ID or indicate the barracks as the delivery address during registration to confirm you are eligible to receive the product.

Q: What happens if my eligibility cannot be verified?

A: If verification fails, the order may be canceled or refunded according to store policy. Ensure correct documentation is submitted to avoid delays.
