The Tubolari Ricamati Generale SOGIT Trieste are embroidered shoulder sleeves designed for registered personnel of the Order Gerosolimitano ed Ospedaliero di S. Giovanni di Gerusalemme (SOGIT). They serve as a uniform insignia for authorised staff and are intended for formal, duty, or ceremonial use.

Definition: a pair of embroidered dark-blue sleeve insignia (tubolari) bearing a silver Greek border, three embroidered shields, and the octagonal Maltese cross. Suitable for tactical, military surplus, and duty uniform applications where authorised.

Main features

These tubolari combine traditional heraldic design with durable materials and precise embroidery for a professional uniform appearance.

- **Exclusive design:** Silver greca (border) topped by three embroidered shields containing the octagonal Maltese cross.
- **High-quality materials:** Dark-blue base fabric with silver-thread embroidery for durability and refined look.
- **Exact dimensions:** Each tubolare measures 7 x 11.5 cm (per piece).
- **Production on request:** Made to order with production completed within 10 days from the order date.
- **Restricted sale:** Available only to authorised SOGIT personnel registered with the national SOGIT office.
- **Minimum order:** Sold in a minimum quantity of 3 pairs.

How to use / When it's useful

These tubolari are applied to uniform sleeves as identification and ceremonial insignia for SOGIT personnel. They are appropriate for formal events, duty shifts, and any situation where official insignia are required.

Quick answer: use them on the uniform sleeves specified by your unit's dress regulations. In most cases, they replace or complement existing shoulder insignia to show rank and affiliation.

Care and notes

Handle the tubolari with care to preserve the embroidery and fabric finish; they are produced to order and intended for authorised personnel only.

- Store flat or on a padded hanger to avoid creasing the embroidery.
- Spot-clean gently; avoid harsh chemicals that can damage metallic thread.
- Order minimum 3 pairs—confirm your authorised registration before purchase.
- Production completes within 10 days from order; allow extra time for shipment.



FAQ

Q: Who can purchase the Tubolari Ricamati Generale SOGIT Trieste?

A: Sale is reserved for authorised SOGIT personnel registered with the national SOGIT office. You must be recognised and registered to place an order.

Q: What are the exact dimensions of each tubolare?

A: Each tubolare measures 7 x 11.5 cm. The pair is designed to fit standard uniform sleeve placements.

Q: How long does production take?

A: Production is completed within 10 days from the order date. Shipping time is separate and depends on destination.

Q: Is there a minimum order quantity?

A: Yes. The minimum order is 3 pairs of tubolari, as these items are produced on request.

Q: What materials are used for the embroidery?

A: The tubolari are made on a dark-blue fabric base with silver-thread embroidery for the greca and shields. Materials are chosen for durability and appearance.

Q: Can these tubolari be used on tactical or duty uniforms?

A: Yes. They are intended for authorised uniform use, including duty and ceremonial contexts where SOGIT insignia are required.

Tip: Choose the correct quantity and confirm authorised registration before ordering. Check your unit's uniform rules for placement, and consider browsing related uniform accessories to complete your set.
