Product overview

Police-Security Ballistic-Stream OC Spray is a professional non-lethal defense spray designed for police, private security officers and other authorized duty personnel. It provides a precise, long-range option to stop an aggressive subject without direct physical contact.



Definition: a high-concentration Oleoresin Capsicum (OC) spray delivered as a directed ballistic stream for tactical, police and security use. Suitable for tactical, duty and military surplus equipment kits.

Main features

Compact and designed for fast, controlled application, the Police-Security spray combines range, power and handling features required by security professionals.

- **Range:** 7–8 metres ballistic stream for distance control.
- **Capacity:** 30 ml canister, approximately 14 bursts of 0.5 seconds each.
- **Active agent:** High-concentration OC (Oleoresin Capsicum) formula for rapid temporary incapacitation.
- **Effects:** Intense tearing, respiratory burning and coughing—effects typically resolve within about 4 hours and are not intended to cause permanent injury.
- **Design:** Directional stream reduces environmental contamination and lowers accidental exposure risk to the operator.
- **Carry features:** Plastic case and metal side clip for secure, practical transport on duty belts or tactical gear.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: aim at the attacker's face from a safe distance and apply short bursts. Maintain at least 1 metre distance to reduce accidental exposure. In most cases, 2–3 short sprays, directed at eyes, nose and mouth, are sufficient to stop an assault.

Use it when you need a non-lethal, stand-off option—crowd control, protective escorts, patrol interventions or any situation where avoiding physical contact is preferable. The ballistic stream is most effective where precision is required and where minimizing contamination of bystanders is important.

Care and notes

Proper storage and routine checks keep the spray effective and safe to use. Sale and use follow national regulations; this product is intended for authorized personnel only.

- **Check expiry:** verify the date on the canister; effectiveness may decline months after expiry.
- **Store properly:** keep in a dry place, away from direct sunlight and excessive heat to avoid pressure changes.
- **Use caution indoors:** even with a directed stream, avoid use in very crowded or enclosed spaces when possible.
- **Purchase requirements:** registration of your service ID is required and sale is reserved to authorized law enforcement or private security personnel.



FAQ

Q: Is the ballistic-stream spray safe to use in crowded places?

A: The directed stream reduces environmental spread compared with fog sprays, but caution is still required. Avoid using it in very confined or densely packed interiors when possible.

Q: What immediate effects should I expect on the target?

A: Expect intense tearing, burning of airways and coughing. These symptoms typically prevent further aggression and usually resolve within about 4 hours.

Q: Can civilians buy and use this spray for self-defence?

A: No. This specific Police-Security product is reserved for law enforcement and authorized private security personnel. Purchase requires service ID registration.

Q: Does the spray have an expiration date?

A: Yes. The canister shows an expiry date. Effectiveness can decrease months after expiry, so check dates before use and replace expired units.

Q: How many uses are in a single canister?

A: Each canister provides about 14 bursts of 0.5 seconds each, which is sufficient for multiple short interventions in emergency situations.

Q: Is any special training required?

A: Authorized users should receive proper training in deployment, legal use and decontamination procedures to ensure safe and lawful use on duty.

Tip: Choose the variant that matches your duty requirements and check expiry and carriage options before adding the Police-Security spray to your kit; also review related tactical and duty equipment to complete your loadout.
