Care and notes

Basic care keeps the enamel and metal finish in good condition and prevents damage to clothing or the badge itself.

- Wipe with a soft, dry cloth to remove fingerprints and dust; avoid abrasive cleaners.
- Keep dry and store in a padded box or display case to prevent scratches.
- Attach clamps firmly to avoid loss; check them periodically if worn on garments.
- Check local or unit regulations before wearing the badge on official duty uniforms.
- Limited stock: demand among collectors and military surplus buyers can be high.
