Quick answer: use it as a beret badge for formal uniforms, ceremonial occasions, or as a collector's item. In most cases, the badge fits standard beret materials and maintains its position during normal activity, but always check the fit before extended wear.

### Care and notes

Basic care keeps the metal finish clean and the fastener functional; handle with standard care for metal accessories.

- Wipe with a soft, dry cloth to remove fingerprints and light dirt.
- Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners that could affect the burnished finish.
- Check the piccaglia fastener periodically to ensure it remains secure.
- Limited availability: stocks are small and items may sell out quickly.

**Q:** What are the badge dimensions?



**A:** The badge measures 4.5 cm in width and 5.5 cm in height. These dimensions make it suitable for most berets without appearing oversized.

**Q:** What material is the badge made from?

**A:** It is made from burnished silver-tone metal. The finish provides a classic look while helping resist everyday wear.

**Q:** How does the badge attach to the beret?

**A:** The badge uses a rear piccaglia fastener (a secure back fitting). Press the fastener through the beret fabric and lock it in place to secure the badge.
