The Hochwasser Land Niedersachsen 2013 medal is a commemorative award for those who assisted during the 2013 flood in Lower Saxony. It is aimed at participants, collectors of military surplus and memorabilia, and those looking for a respectful tribute to civil and rescue service efforts.

Definition: The Hochwasser Land Niedersachsen 2013 is a bronzed commemorative medal issued to recognize assistance during the 2013 flood in the Land Niedersachsen.

Main features

Clear, authentic design with exact inscriptions and two size options for uniform or gala wear.

- **Material:** Bronzed metal for durability and a traditional appearance.
- **Front design:** Central rearing horse (symbol of Niedersachsen) within a shield and the inscription "LAND NIEDERSACHSEN HOCHWASSER 2013".
- **Rear design:** Inscription "IN DANKBARKEIT UND ANERKENNUNG" above an image of an outstretched hand symbolizing aid.
- **Ribbon:** Red ribbon with two vertical white stripes, each 3 mm wide and placed 1 mm from the edges.
- **Sizes available:** Two formats for wearing or display — full-size for uniform use (approximately 35–37 mm) and a smaller gala size (20 mm).

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: Wear the medal on formal uniforms or keep it as a collector's item or memory of the 2013 flood efforts. In most cases, recipients or participants display it during ceremonies or keep it with other military surplus and memorabilia.

The medal suits formal ceremonies, remembrance events, museum displays, or private collections. It also works as a respectful gift for those recognized for their service during the Niedersachsen flood.

Care and notes

Simple care keeps the medal in good condition and preserves inscriptions and ribbon colors.

- Store in a dry, cool place away from direct sunlight to avoid ribbon fading.
- Clean gently with a soft, dry cloth; avoid abrasive cleaners that could damage the bronzed finish.
- Choose the correct size for intended use: larger for uniform display, smaller for gala or wearable keepsakes.
- Respect eligibility and local rules when wearing official-looking medals in public or on duty uniforms.



FAQ

Q: Who is allowed to wear the Hochwasser Land Niedersachsen 2013 medal?

A: The medal may be worn by those who participated in or contributed to relief efforts during the 2013 flood, and by collectors or enthusiasts of military surplus and honors.

Q: How should I wear the medal?

A: It is supplied with a ribbon and can be worn on formal uniforms or formal attire. The larger format suits uniforms, the smaller gala size is for less formal wear or display.

Q: What is the difference between the uniform and gala formats?

A: The main difference is size: the uniform format is approximately 35–37 mm, while the gala format is 20 mm. Both share the same design and material.

Q: What do the inscriptions on the medal mean?

A: The front inscription identifies the region and year: “LAND NIEDERSACHSEN HOCHWASSER 2013.” The back reads “IN DANKBARKEIT UND ANERKENNUNG,” which means “With gratitude and recognition.”

Q: What is the medal made of?

A: The medal is made of bronzed metal, chosen for its durability and traditional look often found in military surplus and commemorative pieces.

Q: Where can I purchase this medal?

A: The medal is available through Tutto Militare, the e-commerce shop specializing in military honors and related items. Check the selected size before purchasing.

Tip: Choose the size that matches your intended use—larger for uniform wear, smaller for gala or personal display—and consider browsing related military surplus and commemorative items to complete a respectful presentation.
