Care and notes

Basic care and practical notes to keep the insignia in good condition:

- Store in a dry place to preserve the enamel and metal finish.
- Handle by the edges to avoid fingerprints on the enamel.
- Ensure clamps are fastened securely when worn on a uniform.
- Stock is limited due to artisanal production; availability may be restricted.

Q: What are the exact dimensions?

A: Each mostrina measures 25 x 50 mm. The listing shows the size so you can check fit for uniforms or display frames.

Q: How do the mostrine attach to a uniform?



A: They use clamp-style rear fasteners for a secure and simple fit. Fasten the clamp to the collar point or fabric edge as needed.

Q: What materials are used?

A: The tabs are enameled (red flame motif) with a silver-colored metal five-point star, as described in the product details.

Q: Are they sold individually or as a pair?

A: These mostrine are sold as a matching pair — one left and one right tab — ready for use or display.
