surplus use. Definition: the Grado Maggiore Cappello Alpino is the metal rank badge mounted on gray?green cloth and worn on the left side of the Cappello Alpino to indicate the rank of Maggiore (Major).

Made to reflect Alpine tradition and service duty, this rank badge combines visible authority with durable materials suitable for ceremonial and field use. It is offered in limited quantities and is popular for tactical, military surplus, and duty uniforms.

Main features

Clean, recognisable design built with durable materials for long-term use.

- **Double gold metal galloon:** prominent metal bands that mark the rank.
- **Gold galloncino:** a narrow gold band set between the galloons for refined contrast.

How to use / When it's useful

Use this insignia to outfit a Cappello Alpino for active duty, ceremonial events, uniform replacement, or for military surplus collections. It is intended for officers who hold the rank of Maggiore and for those restoring authentic Alpine headgear.

Quick answer: this is the Major rank badge meant to be worn on the left side of the Cappello Alpino. In most cases, choose the badge variant and size that match your hat and follow your organisation's uniform rules when wearing it.

Care and notes

Basic care preserves appearance and ensures the badge remains suitable for duty or display. Follow uniform rules and storage best practices.

- Avoid heavy abrasion; clean the cloth with a gentle spot-clean only.
- Keep metal parts dry to prevent tarnish; store in a dry place.
- Choose the correct size and variant to match your Cappello Alpino and uniform regulations.
- Limited availability: allow standard processing and shipping times.

A: The white plume is a distinguishing element associated with senior officers of the Alpine troops and is part of the traditional insignia for higher ranks.
