The Portachiavi Granata Survival Paracord is a compact paracord grenade-style keychain designed for outdoor enthusiasts and anyone who values practical everyday carry.

Product overview

The Paracord Grenade Survival Keychain is a compact multi-tool for outdoor enthusiasts, anglers, and field operators who need lightweight, reliable gear. It combines a short paracord length, fire-starting tool, basic fishing kit and a small knife in a grenade-shaped keychain design.



Definition: a compact survival keychain that stores essential tools for camping, fishing, tactical or duty use. Ideal for hiking, fishing trips, tactical training and everyday carry in military surplus or police-style setups.

Main features

Compact and practical, this keychain groups several survival items into one easy-to-attach unit for backpacks, belts or equipment loops.

- **Carabiner** for quick attachment to packs or belts.
- **3.5 m paracord** with a rated load of 250 kg for shelters, repairs or carrying small loads.
- **Firesteel and cotton tinder** for starting a fire in adverse conditions.
- **Small stainless-steel knife** with a 5 cm blade for cutting and food prep.
- **Basic fishing kit** – 2 hooks, line, 2 floats and 2 swivels for improvised fishing.
- **Aluminum foil** for signaling, food protection or heat reflection.

How to use / When it's useful

Use the keychain by unclipping the carabiner and unwrapping the paracord to access tools quickly. The paracord can be unrolled for shelter building, repairs or as an improvised clothesline; the fishing components allow simple emergency fishing; the firesteel and tinder start fires when needed.

Quick answer: the firesteel and cotton tinder let you start a fire even in poor weather if used correctly. In most cases: the paracord, knife and fishing kit cover common survival and outdoor tasks such as shelter, food and basic repairs.

Care and notes

Regular checks and basic care will keep the keychain functional during extended use.

- Store the firesteel and tinder dry when possible; the firesteel is designed to resist moisture but performs best if kept dry.
- Handle the 5 cm stainless-steel blade carefully; keep it clean and sharpened as needed.
- Inspect the paracord before load-bearing use and replace it if frayed or damaged.
- Individual components can be replaced when worn or used up; keep spare hooks, line and tinder for long trips.

FAQ

Q: How long is the paracord and what load can it bear?

A: The included paracord is 3.5 m long and is rated to support up to 250 kg. Use it for light shelter work, repairs or as an emergency line.



Q: Is the firesteel waterproof?

A: The firesteel is designed to resist moisture and to work in damp conditions, but it is not fully waterproof. Storing it dry will extend its reliability and lifespan.

Q: How sharp is the knife?

A: The kit includes a small stainless-steel knife with a 5 cm blade. It is sharp enough for cutting cordage, preparing food and general camp tasks; handle it with care.

Q: Can I replace the fishing and tinder components?

A: Yes. The kit's individual items (hooks, line, tinder, etc.) are consumable and can be replaced as needed. Keep spares for longer trips.

Q: How heavy is the keychain?

A: The keychain is described as compact and lightweight. Exact weight is not specified, but it is made for easy carry on a belt, pack or keyring without significant bulk.

Q: Is this product suitable for tactical or military use?

A: The keychain is designed as an accessory for outdoor, tactical and duty-style kits and fits military surplus or police gear layouts. It is a practical toolset, not a certified military-issue device.

Tip: Choose the variant that best fits your carry system and keep spare consumables (tinder, fishing hooks, extra paracord) on hand. Browse related tactical and outdoor items to build a matched, reliable kit for your next trip.
