Product overview

The ALTHEA Medal is a service medal for personnel who served with EUFOR in Bosnia and Herzegovina during the 2004–2007 mission; it is suitable for veterans, collectors, military, police, and tactical/military surplus shoppers. This product reproduces the medal as described for display or uniform wear.



Definition: The ALTHEA Medal is a round service medal linked to EUFOR operations in Bosnia and Herzegovina. It recognizes at least 30 days of qualifying service during the mission.

Main features

Key details and visual elements that identify the ALTHEA Medal.

- **Distinctive design:** Round medal in darkened silver finish featuring 12 stars symbolizing unity and solidarity in Europe.
- **Latin inscription:** Reverse bears the phrase **PRO PACE UNUM** (together for peace).
- **Ribbon:** 37 mm wide blue ribbon with a central yellow?gold stripe, representing the EU and the forces.
- **Metal clasp:** Bronzeworked metal clasp on the ribbon engraved with **ALTHEA**.
- **Available formats:** Large version for uniform and 20 mm gala version for dress uniform (selectable from the product options).
- **Suitable uses:** Wear on duty or dress uniforms, or keep as a collectible or display item.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: choose the large version for standard uniform wear and the 20 mm gala version for dress or formal uniforms. Use the ribbon and clasp to attach the medal as required by your unit or display it in a case.

In most cases, veterans display this medal with other service decorations or wear it according to their service regulations. Collectors and tactical/military surplus buyers will find it useful as a historical piece or uniform accessory for reenactment and display.

Care and notes

Keep the medal clean and stored dry; handle the ribbon and clasp gently to preserve finish and lettering.

- Store in a dry, cool place away from direct sunlight to avoid ribbon fading.
- Clean metal parts with a soft cloth; avoid abrasive cleaners that can damage the finish.
- Check the clasp and stitching before wear to ensure secure attachment.
- Availability is limited; product demand is high.
- Note: official award eligibility is based on service records—confirm award entitlement with the appropriate authority.

FAQ

Q: What is the minimum length of service required to receive the ALTHEA Medal?

A: The minimum qualifying service for the medal is at least 30 days during the EUFOR mission



period specified (2004–2007).

Q: Which formats are available for purchase?

A: The medal is available in a large format for uniform wear and a 20 mm gala format for dress uniform. Choose the option from the product menu.

Q: What do the 12 stars on the medal represent?

A: The 12 stars symbolize unity, solidarity, and harmony among the peoples of Europe.

Q: What does the inscription "PRO PACE UNUM" mean?

A: The Latin phrase **PRO PACE UNUM** translates to "together for peace."

Q: Does the ribbon color have a specific meaning?

A: Yes. The blue ribbon represents the European Union and the central yellow?gold stripe symbolizes the forces involved in the mission.

Q: Is this an officially issued government medal?

A: This product represents the ALTHEA Medal design as linked to the EUFOR mission. Official award status and issuance depend on military authorities and service records—verify entitlement with the appropriate issuing body.

Tip: Select the correct variant (large for uniform, 20 mm for gala) before adding to cart, and consider browsing related commemorative and military surplus items to complete a display or uniform set.
