This metal CASM Centro Alti Studi Militari badge is a historic, enameled lapel pin for collectors,



veterans, and enthusiasts of military surplus, tactical gear, and police history. It is suitable for display, civilian wear, or adding to a collection of insignia.

Definition: a small enameled metal badge produced in the 1950s, bearing the symbols of the Italian Army, Navy and Air Force and fitted with an eyelet for attachment to civilian clothing.

Main features

Care and notes

Handle as a vintage metal badge: simple care will preserve the enamel and metal finish while keeping the eyelet functional.

- Keep dry and avoid prolonged exposure to moisture to reduce risk of tarnish.
- Clean gently with a soft, dry cloth; avoid abrasive cleaners or polishes.
- Check the eyelet before attaching to fabrics to prevent snagging or damage.
- Expect minor signs of age consistent with a 1950s production piece.
