Main features

- **Parachute nylon construction:** three outer cords in gray, white and red.
- **Internal strands:** five white high-strength nylon inner cords inside the sheath.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: untie the bracelet to access the inner cords when you need cordage; re-tie or replace as needed. In most cases, the available cord is intended for temporary fixes and utility use rather than certified load-bearing or life-safety applications.

Care and notes

Simple care extends the life of the paracord and keeps it ready for use.

- Hand wash with mild soap and cold water; rinse and air dry away from direct heat.
- Store dry and avoid prolonged sun exposure to reduce material aging.
- Not designed or certified for climbing, rescue, or other load-bearing safety uses.

FAQ

Q: How do I request a custom length?

A: Send your wrist measurement in centimeters measured with a tape measure. We will adjust the bracelet length to fit that measurement.

Q: Is the bracelet water-resistant?



A: Yes. The parachute nylon resists water and typical weather exposure. Allow the bracelet to air dry after heavy wetting.

Q: Can I use the cord in emergency situations?

A: Yes. The bracelet can be untied to provide meters of cord useful for temporary repairs, shelter, or gear fastening. It is not certified for life-saving or load-bearing tasks.

Q: What are the bracelet dimensions?

A: The bracelet width is 2 cm. Length is customized based on your wrist measurement in centimeters.

Q: Is this bracelet suitable for everyday wear?

A: Yes. Its compact profile and durable material make it comfortable for daily use and outdoor activities.

Q: What materials and colors are used?

A: Three outer parachute nylon cords in gray, white and red, with five internal high-strength white nylon strands for cordage when needed.
