In most cases, this badge is used for uniform restoration, commemorative wear, parades, or as part of a military surplus collection. It is compact enough for regular wear and detailed enough for display purposes.

Care and notes

Maintain appearance and function with simple care and be aware of limited stock.

- Store dry to avoid tarnishing; wipe with a soft, dry cloth to clean.
- Avoid abrasive cleaners or prolonged exposure to moisture.
- Handle the pin gently to prevent bending or loosening.
- Availability is limited; quantities may run out due to demand.
