Medaglia Antica Babilonia Iraq 2006 Croce Rossa is a commemorative campaign medal



issued to personnel of the Corpo Militare Croce Rossa and military staff who served with the Red Cross during Operation Antica Babilonia in Iraq. It is intended for veterans, collectors, museums and buyers interested in military surplus, tactical memorabilia, or duty and police history.

Definition: a 37 mm round commemorative medal recognizing humanitarian service during Operation Antica Babilonia (Iraq, 2003–2006). The piece serves as both a display item and a historical keepsake; availability is limited.

Main features

Key physical and symbolic details that matter for collectors and display purposes:

- **Size:** 37 mm diameter, single available format.
- **Obverse design:** central profile of a Muslim spiritual leader wearing the imama, decorated with feathers.
- **Perimeter inscription:** uppercase engraving "OPERAZIONE IRAQ 2003-2006" marking the operation period.
- **Reverse design:** raised Italian Red Cross (CRI) emblem surrounded by the words "Croce Rossa Italiana".

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: intended primarily as a commemorative and collectible item rather than a modern service decoration.

In most cases, buyers choose it for display, historical research, or as a veteran keepsake after confirming condition and provenance.

Care and notes

Simple care extends the life and appearance of the medal; handle and store it carefully to preserve its details and inscription.

- Store in a dry, cool place away from direct sunlight to prevent tarnish.
- Clean gently with a soft, dry cloth; avoid abrasive cleaners or chemicals.
- Available only in the 37 mm format—no other sizes are listed.
- Limited availability: condition and stock may vary; check the specific listing for notes on



wear and provenance.

A: The medal measures 37 mm in diameter and is offered only in this size.

Q: What inscriptions are on the medal?

A: The perimeter reads "OPERAZIONE IRAQ 2003-2006" and the reverse shows a raised Italian Red Cross (CRI) emblem with the words "Croce Rossa Italiana".

Q: Who originally received this medal?

A: The decoration was conferred to personnel of the Corpo Militare Croce Rossa and military staff assigned to the Red Cross contingent during Operation Antica Babilonia in Iraq.

Q: What does the central depiction represent?

A: The central image shows the profile of a Muslim spiritual leader wearing an imama, symbolizing the local cultural and humanitarian context of the mission.

Q: Is this medal suitable for display in a museum or private collection?

A: Yes. Its historical and humanitarian significance makes it appropriate for museum exhibits, collectors of military surplus, and personal remembrance displays.

Q: Are there other formats or versions available?

A: No other sizes are listed; this item is available exclusively in the 37 mm format. Condition and production details may vary by listing.
