Product overview

The Zaino Militare Eagle Back Pack Nero is a 65-liter military-style backpack designed for outdoor enthusiasts, tactical operators, and duty or police personnel who need a durable,



organized carry solution. It combines heavy-duty construction with MOLLE compatibility for modular accessory attachment.

Definition: A 65 L tactical backpack made from 1000 Denier nylon with MOLLE webbing and multiple pockets for mission, hiking, or daily use.

Main features

Built for durability, comfort and modular use, the Eagle Back Pack Nero includes features that support mission readiness and everyday carry.

- **Material:** Made from Nylon 1000 Denier for high abrasion resistance and long service life.
- **Capacity:** 65 liters of main storage space for gear, clothing, or equipment.
- **MOLLE webbing:** External MOLLE pass-throughs for attaching pouches and accessories.
- **Ergonomic back:** Preformed dorsal panel for improved comfort during long carries.
- **Large opening:** Main compartment opens on three sides via a quiet (silenced) zipper with a cord pull for fast access.
- **Carry & recovery handles:** Three reinforced handles, including a top evacuation-style handle.
- **Accessory organization:** Hidden central pocket, flap pocket, two 5.56 mag inserts with elastic Velcro straps, lanyard with hook, and three pen inserts.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: Use this pack for multi-day hikes, tactical missions, patrol duty, or as a large daily carry pack for work that requires organized storage. It suits military surplus users, tactical operators, police, and outdoor enthusiasts.

In most cases, place heavier items low and close to the back, keep radios or hydration reservoirs in the main pocket near the antenna/cord openings, and attach modular pouches to the MOLLE webbing for quick access.

Care and notes

Simple care keeps the pack functional and prolongs its life; handle zippers and Velcro gently and avoid overloading beyond comfortable carry limits.

- Wipe clean with a damp cloth; avoid machine washing or tumble drying.
- Material is water-resistant and constructed to shed light rain, but not guaranteed fully waterproof—avoid full submersion.
- Keep drainage holes clear to prevent water or debris buildup in the base.
- Check Velcro and elastic straps periodically for wear; repair or replace if they lose tension.

Q: What is the backpack capacity?

A: The pack holds 65 liters of volume, suitable for multi-day loads or extensive gear kits. Use internal organization to separate clothing, tools, and electronics.

Q: What material is the pack made from?

A: It is made from Nylon 1000 Denier, a high-strength textile commonly used in tactical and military surplus gear for abrasion resistance and durability.

Q: Is the backpack waterproof?

A: The construction and fabric provide good water resistance against rain and splashes, but it is not fully waterproof—avoid immersing the pack in water for extended periods.

Q: Are there pockets for magazines and radios?

A: Yes. The pack includes two magazine inserts sized for cal. 5.56 with elastic Velcro retention, plus openings in the main pocket for antennas and radio cables.

Q: How many carry handles does it have?

A: There are three reinforced carry/recovery handles; the top handle is suitable for emergency evacuation use or quick grabs.

Q: Can I run a hydration tube through the pack?

A: Yes. The main compartment has three passthrough openings that accommodate hydration tubes, radio cables, or antenna routing for convenient use in the field.

Tip: Choose the right variant or size for your typical missions and consider pairing the pack with compatible MOLLE pouches or a hydration bladder to optimize setup; browse related tactical and military surplus items to complete your kit.
