How to use / When it's useful

In most cases, place the badge through medium-weight fabric or onto a backing card for display to prevent fabric damage. It is also a suitable collectible or gift for someone interested in Alpine Corps history or tactical memorabilia.

Care and notes

Basic care will preserve the badge's detail and finish; handle gently and store in a dry place.

- Clean with a soft, dry cloth; avoid abrasive cleaners or strong chemicals.
- Be careful when pinning to thin or delicate fabrics—use a protective backing if needed.
- Small parts and a sharp pin: keep out of reach of children.
- Limited availability: quantities are restricted, so check current stock before purchasing.
