Product overview

The Distintivo Gruppo Artiglieria Alpina 2 Vicenza is a painted metal badge that represents the Italian Alpine Artillery Group "Vicenza". It is intended for collectors, military history enthusiasts, and those building tactical or military surplus displays.

Main features

- Avoid abrasive cleaners or rough handling that could chip the painted surface.
- Store in a padded or lined display case to prevent scratches.
- If provenance or origin is important, request condition and source details before purchase.

Q: What are the badge dimensions?

A: The badge measures 2.5 cm in width and 3.5 cm in height. It is compact and suitable for display or wearing with care.
