Product overview

The pair of Tubolari Plastica Kaki Maggiore Esercito are plastic rank slides designed for the shirt, sweater or raincoat of a Maggiore (Major) in the Italian Esercito. They are intended for serving Army officers and verified collectors who hold the required authorization.



Definition: These are kaki plastic shoulder tubolari (rank slides) bearing a gold-framed turreted crown topped by a five-point gold star, used to identify a senior officer's rank. Ideal for military surplus, tactical, or duty uniform applications.

Main features

Compact, lightweight and visually distinct rank tubolari, made for practical daily wear on service uniforms.

- **Material:** Durable kaki plastic — lightweight and economical compared with metal or cloth ranks.
- **Design:** Gold frame with a gold turreted crown and five-point star at the center, signalling authority and prestige.
- **Dimensions:** Pair measures 6 cm (width) x 9 cm (height).
- **Fit:** Suitable for application on shirt, sweater or raincoat.
- **Heritage:** Introduced to Italian military uniform use in 1946.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: Slide the tubolari onto the shoulder seam of the shirt, sweater or raincoat where rank slides are worn; ensure proper alignment so the emblem faces outward and is clearly visible. In most cases, they are fitted over existing shoulder straps or sewn-in sleeves depending on uniform type.

These tubolari are useful whenever you need a clear, lightweight rank indicator for duty uniform, ceremonial wear, or when replacing older metal or cloth ranks. They work well for military surplus collectors and for routine operational use on tactical or duty garments.

Care and notes

Simple care preserves appearance and longevity; store flat and avoid prolonged exposure to heat that could deform plastic.

- Keep clean with a damp cloth; avoid solvents or abrasive cleaners.
- Store flat in a cool, dry place to prevent warping.
- Sale restricted: purchase requires a copy of the tesserino proving Esercito membership or, during registration, listing the barracks as the delivery address.
- Collectors must provide a prefectural license (licenza prefettizia) under ex art. 28 TULPS to buy this product.

FAQ

Q: Who can buy these tubolari Plastica Kaki Maggiore Esercito?



A: Only Esercito personnel and collectors with a valid prefectural license under ex art. 28 TULPS are eligible to purchase. Proof of status is required at checkout.

Q: What are the exact dimensions?

A: Each tubolare measures 6 cm in width and 9 cm in height. The product is sold as a pair for both shoulders.

Q: How do I prove I belong to the Esercito to complete the purchase?

A: You must upload a copy of your tesserino (military ID) or, when registering, indicate your barracks as the delivery address to confirm affiliation.

Q: Why are these tubolari made of plastic?

A: Plastic tubolari were introduced for practicality and cost efficiency; they are lighter and less expensive than metal or cloth rank insignia while remaining visible and durable for daily use.

Q: What do the gold symbols mean?

A: The gold turreted crown and five-point star denote authority and the status of a senior officer (Maggiore). They are traditional rank identifiers on the uniform.

Q: Are these tubolari official issue or aftermarket items?

A: These tubolari follow the traditional design used since 1946 for Maggiore rank on Italian uniforms. Sale is controlled and intended for authorized personnel and licensed collectors.
